

Dear Mr. Moe,

The 2013 Point Bock Run is scheduled for Saturday March 2, 2013 with a noon start time.

We have appreciated the city's assistance and support which has helped make our race successful as last year we reached our cap of 2,000 entries.

We are requesting permission to use the same route for the Point Bock Run that we have used the last four years and have the following road closures and parking restrictions implemented.

- Close Water Street from Francis Street to Matilda Street at 8:00 am for the start/finish area setup and keep it closed until 3:00 pm.
- Divert Water St. traffic onto Williams St. from noon to 1 p.m.
- Close West River Drive from County Highway HH north to West Mapleridge Drive between noon and 1 p.m.
- Parking be prohibited on Water Street from Francis Street south to Whiting Avenue, and Whiting Avenue from Water Street to County Highway HH. We request that temporary "no parking" signs be installed for the morning of March 2nd and removed by early afternoon.


We believe these road closures and restrictions on parking will make the race course safer for all runners and spectators involved.



 Bock Race Course

 1/2 Way turn



RE: Ciclovía WI

Dear Mr. Moe,

UWSP Adventure Tours (a program of the school of Health Promotion and Human Development) would like to propose the 2nd Annual Ciclovía WI with an additional smaller route and improved logistics. The first event, held this year, had a successful turnout despite snow and rain that morning. With about 150-200 participants (an exact number would be impossible to measure since there is no registration for this free event), participants traveled the loop via bicycle, on foot, with rollerblades, etc. and participated at each of the 4 Active Rest Stops. Seventy four participants completed surveys and 95% of them said that they enjoyed the activities and resources available through Ciclovía WI. Besides their main method of travel, 95% of surveyed participants participated in at least one Active Rest Stop activity (such as Zumba, Skate Jam, or the Kids Zone) and 51% participated in more than one Active Rest Stop activity. Also, 66% of surveyed participants said that they would use their bicycle more in general after having participated in Ciclovía WI.

To recap: This event is a free open-to-the-public bike/pedestrian loop around the north side of Stevens Point. Following the lead of similar events in Bogota, Columbia, Portland, OR, New York City, and Madison this statewide event will include a safe route through part of the city, "active" rest stops such as Zumba classes, a kids zone, vendors (local & Midwest), bike safety and demos, and more.

The main goal of the event is to get people active while exploring the City of Stevens Point. For free, participants can join in the fun of travelling this looped route by riding their bike, walking, jogging, pushing a stroller, by wheelchair, rollerblading, etc. It will be a great way to get families out of the house, enjoy a fun, active, and wellness event, and patronize businesses along the way.

Updates for 2013: The proposed date/times are Sunday, Sep. 19, 2013 from 10am-2pm (if the Packers start at 12pm) or 11am-3pm (if the Packers start at 3:30pm), which has been cleared as an available community event date by the Stevens Point Area Convention & Visitor's Bureau.

Safety is an important focus and last year's event had no accidents or negative reports from participants, volunteers, or the PD. Last year I met with Joel Lemke, Marty Skibba, and Sergeant Tim Davy of the SPPD to discuss logistics, safety, and routing for this event. The route was not closed to motor vehicles last year. However, since one of the goals of Ciclovía WI is to eventually close roads in order to have a safe and unique experience while creating a linear park just as many of these types of events do, I am proposing that we close roads along an additional smaller route for Ciclovía WI 2013.



I have met with Sgt. Davy and talked with Tom Schrader at Parks & Rec. and both have said that they don't see issues with closing these roads and that these three options are definitely possible (please see attached route, the top route is the same as last year, the bottom 3 are new proposals). To make the closing of roads along the additional route feasible this route will be very small (about 1-1.5 miles long), high traffic areas were avoided, SP police officers will be contracted at specific traffic crossings, volunteers will be positioned along the route for information and added assistance, signage and/or road paint will navigate the participants through the route, detours and signage will be posted as needed, about ½ of it will run along Pfiffner Park trails, route residents will be notified through multiple means, and pre-event promotions and advertising will be much greater (as noted by the awarded 2012 Community Foundation of Central WI grant).

Just as for 2012, UWSP Adventure Tours will lead the event coordination and development with help from local partners & supporters – Active Portage County, Stevens Point Area Convention & Visitors Bureau, and more... Upon approval, I will setup a volunteer committee again to plan and organize this event for use of best practices and expanding event resources. I'm estimating there will be between 250-600 people participating throughout this event in 2013 and it will hopefully grow to be as large (or larger than) Walk Wisconsin in future years. Active Portage County supported this event with a grant for 2012 and the Community Foundation of Central WI has awarded a \$3,000 grant for the 2013 event!

Just as the 2012 event did, I believe next year's event will serve the general public interest reflected in the goals stated above and the event will not cause safety or capacity problems. With support from the City of Stevens Point I will work with local municipal departments (Engineering, Fire/EMS, Parks/Rec/Forestry, Police, etc.) in finalizing the event route, planning for emergencies, and other logistics.

I would very much appreciate your continued support in this event, approval of last year's route, and approval of closing roads for one of the proposed new routes (as an additional route). Feel free to contact me with any questions.
