Consideration and possible action on the following:

2. Actions taken at the Special Public Protection meeting of December 19, 2012.

President Stroik summarized the actions taken at the Special Public Protection meeting which entailed a motion to approve. The two issues were combined to approve the Class B Beer and Liquor-6 Month License for the Player's Lounge, 2124 Rice Street, Stevens Point, WI and include the extension of the licensed premise to include the Sports Center.

Ald. Patton **moved**, Ald. Wiza seconded, to approve the actions taken at the Special Public Protection meeting of December 19, 2012.

Ald. Suomi questioned when the six month extension starts.

President Stroik answered January 1, 2013. He clarified that Mr. Glisczynski's current license expires December 31, 2012 and that this license would be for January 1 through June, 2013.

Ald. Suomi then asked if the renewal will be for every year.

Ald. Wiza replied yes, it will be considered every year.

Ald. Suomi questioned the process if there are complaints.

City Attorney Molepske said it would depend on the severity of the complaint. For example, if there are two or three complaints of serving minors, a sworn complaint could be brought to Common Council in which the license could be suspended for a period of time or revoked.

Ald. Suomi stated the Players Lounge has done a good job abiding by the rules. Her concern is the time frame from the time of the complaints to when they are addressed by Council.
