Policy 3.01

Mayor Halverson indicated there is a grammatical issue in the last
paragraph that will be addressed.

Alderman O'Meara indicated that he feels it is inappropriate that
management employees would have to wait until one year of
employment to elapse prior to beginning further education.

Alderman Phillips stated that an employee may be required to pass a
course as a condition of their probation. He feels wording similar to
"nothing shall preclude a manager from requiring an employee to
participate in training prior to completing one year of employment".

Alderman Slowinski asked about the sub-heading for the
Water/Wastewater hourly employee section. It was explained that each
work division was identified in a similar manner.
