Dear Committee Members;

I respectfully request your consideration of the UWSP Department of Military Science's request to hold an event within the city on April 18, 2015.

The Corps of Cadets is planning "Reeder's Ruck March," a competitive event designed to raise funds for the "Alex Reeder Memorial Scholarship." Alex Reeder was a Cadet in our program last year when he was killed in a motorcycle accident.

Alex exemplified the best of what we look for in our Cadets as Scholars, Athletes, and Leaders. "Reeder's Ruck March" will allow participants the opportunity to take on Alex' favorite training event. Each participant will complete an eight mile course while carrying a backpack, or "ruck sack", weighing at least 35 pounds.

I am enclosing a briefing that provides some detail regarding our planning process and our tentative route. We have made initial coordination with the Stevens Point Police Department and the Department of Parks and Recreation. If approved, the Start/Finish line will be in the city square. Participants will be limited to 200, and all will be instructed to park at Piffner Pioneer Park. Street crossings will be staffed by volunteers and medical personnel will be stationed throughout the course to ensure participant safety.



RE: Request to produce the Stevens Point Area YMCA Point Duathlon on August 22, 2015
(Nonprofit event fundraiser for the Stevens Point Area YMCA)

Our race is planned and implemented by the Stevens Point Area YMCA and is staged from Illinois Avenue near the Allen Center on UWSP Campus. The run courses consist of roads and paths on UWSP Campus, Schmeekle Reserve, and surrounding areas. Bicycle routes go through the townships of Hull and Dewey. This race has previously been held by the United Way of Portage County. Registration and set-up will begin Friday afternoon, August 21, and the event is expected to conclude by 12:00am on Saturday, August 22. Racers will be on the described courses on Saturday from 8:30 am to 11:00 am. Approximately 500 participants are expected.

Traffic control and aid is provided by volunteers, the Town of Hull Fire Department, and the Portage County Sheriff's Department on the bike course and the Stevens Point Police Department and Stevens Point Rotary Club on the run courses. Traffic control takes the form of handheld stop/slow signs provided by the Stevens Point Street Department. We would like to shut down *Illinois Avenue* between *Maria Drive* and *Fourth Avenue*, and *Michigan Avenue* between *Northpoint Drive* and *Stanley Avenue*. Volunteers serve at all intersections. I have attached course maps for your reference.



1st Run – UWSP Campus Run (2.08M)

From the START line on Illinois Ave in front of the UWSP Allen Center, runners will; head North on Illinois Ave to Maria, then left onto the Eastbound lane of Maria to the driveway between the George Stein Building and Thomson Hall – then go South (left) on sidewalk past Knutzen Hall, the Debot Center,


Hansen Hall and Neale Hall –after Neale Hall runners will go West (right) to Isadore Street where they will head


South (left) and then veer across Fourth Ave to the left between the Collins Classroom Center and the College of Professional Studies toward the Noel Fine Arts Bldg - then head East (left) across the sundial (*in front of the mural on the Natural Resources Bldg*) and past the North side of the LRC to Reserve Street – they will then go South (right) across Reserve in front of the Dreyfus Center heading South on Reserve and past the Old Main Bldg (**DO NOT CROSS MAIN ST**) – then take loop up to the front of Old Main and back down loop to Fremont Street – then North (left) on Fremont, around Lot X and then right on Reserve to sidewalk between Pray-Sims Hall and Lot T – then left on Illinois and right into Lot Q to TRANSITION AREA



Bike – Town of Hull & Dewey (16.5M)


From transition in Lot Q, bikers will exit the lot and immediately mount their bikes while heading East onto Michigan Ave – then North (left) on Michigan Ave to Northpoint Drive – then East (right) on Northpoint to Wilshire Blvd – then North (left) on Wilshire to Jordan Road – then turn right and continue East on Jordan to Willow Springs – then North (left) on Willow Springs to Dewey Drive – then West (left) on Dewey Drive to N Reserve Drive – then South (left) on Reserve back to Jordan, Wilshire, Northpoint, Michigan, and then back into Lot Q to TRANSITION AREA





2nd Run – Around Lake Joanis through Schmeeckle (2.06M)

From transition, head South on Illinois Ave (*staying Left*) to 4th Avenue – then left on 4th (*staying Left*) and then North (left) onto Michigan Ave past Maria/ Minnesota to Schmeeckle Reserve – then a right into Schmeeckle and a quick left onto the Lake Loop Trail at the John Joanis Memorial heading North. Pass the Sedge Meadow Trail and continue East on the Lake Loop Trail. Continue past the Plank Trail and the Moses Creek Trail and head South on the Lake Loop. Continue on the Lake loop to the South Shore and veer left out to Minnesota Ave (*staying Left*), 4th Ave (*staying Left*), Illinois (*staying Left*) and on to the FINISH LINE in front of the Allen Center.


