RE: Request to host the Stevens Point Area YMCA Frostbite Road Race and Winter Walk- Presented by Community First Bank on December 5, 2015.

Our race is coordinated by the Stevens Point Area YMCA. It is staged from the Stevens Point Area YMCA and includes: Prentice, 4th, 2nd, Bukolt, Front, Northpoint, Old Wausau, Casimir, and Franklin Streets (maps attached). We have been producing the race successfully and safely for 39 years. The route is the same as it was the last six years. There will be congestion on city roads during the first part of the race. For the safety of the participants, we request partial or complete shut down of 4th and 2nd streets during the first 20 minutes of the race. Traffic control and aid is provided by volunteers from the Stevens Point Area YMCA elsewhere along the course.

Registration and set-up will begin Friday afternoon, December 4th. The event is expected to conclude by 3pm on December 5th. Racers will actually be on the described courses on Saturday from noon to 3:00pm. Approximately 500 participants are expected.

We are writing to request permission to have chickens on our property at 203 Union Street, Stevens Point, WI. We would like to keep 4 hens for egg production for our family. We are both interested in a healthier lifestyle and think raising food locally is important. We are also looking at this as an interesting retirement project.

The chickens will be housed in a fully insulated coop behind a current out building on our property. Any waste will be composted in a remote area away from the house and street. We currently are active composters and are familiar with proper composting techniques to prevent odor and vermin.


The coop itself will also have an enclosed outdoor run of approximately 10x12 feet to prevent the chickens from roaming far afield.

We have spoken with our neighbors and they are all on board with the idea. We have included signatures of those who were available to sign a document.


We have also included a map of the property indicating where the coop will be located.



