East on Northpoint Dr. to Michigan Ave.
South on Michigan Ave. to Maria Dr.
West on Maria Dr. to Reserve St.
South on Reserve St. to Fourth St. turns into Fremont St. to High St.
West on High St. to Reserve St.
South on Reserve St. to Portage St.
West on Portage St. back to the Sundial


As always, we will work with a representative from the Stevens Point Police Department, along with UW-Stevens Point Protective Services, to assist with the logistics of the run.

RE: Request to produce the Stevens Point Area YMCA Point Duathlon on August 20, 2016.
(Nonprofit event fundraiser for the Stevens Point Area YMCA)

Our race is planned and implemented by the Stevens Point Area YMCA and is staged from Illinois Avenue near the Allen Center on UWSP Campus. The run courses consist of roads and paths on UWSP Campus, Schmeekle Reserve, and surrounding areas. Bicycle routes go through the townships of Hull and Dewey. This race has previously been held by the United Way of Portage County. Registration and set-up will begin Friday afternoon, August 19, and the event is expected to conclude by 12:00pm on Saturday, August 20. Racers will be on the described courses on Saturday from 8:30 am to 11:00 am. Approximately 500 participants are expected.

Traffic control and aid is provided by volunteers, the Town of Hull Fire Department, and the Portage County Sheriff's Department on the bike course and the Stevens Point Police Department and Stevens Point Rotary Club on the run courses. Traffic control takes the form of handheld stop/slow signs provided by the Stevens Point Street Department. We would like to shut down *Illinois Avenue* between *Maria Drive* and *Fourth Avenue*, and *Michigan Avenue* between *Northpoint Drive* and *Stanley Avenue*. Volunteers serve at all intersections. I have attached course maps for your reference.




2016 Point Duathlon – 1st Run (Campus Run)



1st Run Course Directions

From the START line on Illinois Ave in front of the UWSP Allen Center, run North on Illinois Ave toward Maria Dr. Turn left onto Maria (*staying left*), then left onto Isadore St (*staying left*). Turn left onto the sidewalk between the Collins Classroom Center and the Noel Fine Arts Center, South of Lot E. Run East between the mural on the Natural Resources Building and the Sundial, and past the North side of the Learning Resources Center to Reserve St. Turn right onto Reserve St heading south (*staying left*) to Main St (DO NOT CROSS MAIN ST), then take the sidewalk loop up in front of Old Main and back down to Fremont St. Turn left heading North on Fremont St, around lot X, and right onto Reserve St (*staying right*), and right onto sidewalk between Pray-Sims Hall and Lot T. Make final left turn onto Illinois Ave and right into Lot Q TRANSITION AREA.


2016 Point Duathlon – 2nd Run (Schmeekle Run)



2nd Run Course Directions

From transition, run South on Illinois Ave (*staying left*) to 4th Ave. Turn left onto 4th Ave (*staying left*), then cross and turn left (north) onto Michigan Ave toward Schmeekle Reserve (*staying right*). Turn right into Schmeekle Reserve and make a quick left at the John Joanis Memorial to follow the Lake Loop Trail clockwise around Lake Joanis. Continue on the Lake Loop Trail to the South shore and veer left out to Minnesota Ave (*staying left*), turn right onto 4th Ave (*staying left*), right onto Illinois Ave (*staying left*), and cross the FINISH LINE in front of the Allen Center.

Bike Course Directions

From TRANSITION AREA in Lot Q, exit East end of lot turning left (North) onto Michigan Ave toward Northpoint Dr. Turn right at Michigan Ave/Northpoint Dr intersection onto Northpoint, followed by left onto Wilshire Blvd. Ride to North on Wilshire Blvd until T-intersection, then turn right onto Jordan Rd. Turn left onto Willow Springs Dr and ride North, then turn left onto Dewey Dr., followed by left onto N. Reserve Dr heading back toward Jordan Rd. Turn left onto Jordan Rd, right onto Wilshire Blvd, right onto Northpoint Dr., left onto Michigan, and back to the Lot Q TRANSITION AREA.

(Nonprofit event fundraiser for the Stevens Point Area YMCA)

Our race is planned and implemented by the Stevens Point Area YMCA and is staged from Lot Q on UWSP Campus. The proposed children's bike course route is mapped below. Kids ages 7-9 will bike one lap and ages 10-12 will bike two laps.

Traffic control and aid is provided by volunteers on the bike course. Traffic control takes the form of handheld stop/slow signs provided by the Stevens Point Street Department. As was done last year, we request to close Michigan Avenue, between Maria Dr and 4th Ave. We plan to close the road for the shortest amount of time possible. In addition, we request closure of one lane of traffic (the lane closest to the sidewalk) for the duration of the race. We learned last year that kids are not able to remain on the sidewalks at all times, and oncoming traffic posed a threat to their safety. The race begins at 6:00pm, and will finish before 7:00pm.



We are again asking permission to hold a Trivia Parade prior to the 2015 Trivia Contest on WWSP 90FM radio. We will again be registering teams in advance at the 90FM studios, and will ask Trivia teams to be in the parade on April 15. We would like to start the parade at 4:00 P.M. in the parking lot on Illinois Avenue (lot Q). The route that the parade would follow would be the same as last year, it follows:

Illinois avenue north to Maria Drive, Turn left.
West on Maria Drive to Isadore Street, Turn left.
South on Isadore Street to Portage Street, Turn left.
East on Portage Street to Phillips Street, Turn right.
South on Phillips Street to College Avenue, Turn left.
East on College Street to Reserve, Turn left.
North on Reserve to High Street, Turn right.
East on High to Fremont Street, Turn right.
South on Fremont to Simms Avenue, Turn left.
East on Simms into the P.J. Jacobs parking lot.

The parade should last about 1 hour, from beginning to end. We ask that the above route be approved. If there are any questions, please contact Jim Oliva at 321-0601. We will provide 8 people to help with the smooth flow of the parade, if needed.

Here is the parade route, announce it.

Illinois avenue north to Maria Drive, Turn left.

West on Maria Drive to Isadore Street, Turn left.

South on Isadore Street to Portage Street, Turn left.

East on Portage Street to Phillips Street, Turn right.

South on Phillips Street to College Avenue, Turn left.

East on College Street to Reserve, Turn left.

North on Reserve to High Street, Turn right.

East on High to Fremont Street, Turn right.

South on Fremont to Simms Avenue, Turn left.

East on Simms into the P.J. Jacobs parking lot.
