RE: Request to host the Stevens Point Area YMCA Frostbite Road Race and Winter Walk- Presented by Community First Bank on December 3, 2016.

Our race is coordinated by the Stevens Point Area YMCA. It is staged from the Stevens Point Area YMCA and includes: Prentice, 4<sup>th</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, Bukolt, Front, Northpoint, Old Wausau, Casimir, and Franklin Streets (maps attached). We have been producing the race successfully and safely for 40 years. The route is the same as it was the last six years. There will be congestion on city roads during the first part of the race. For the safety of the participants, we request partial or complete shut down of 4<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> streets during the first 20 minutes of the race. Traffic control and aid is provided by volunteers from the Stevens Point Area YMCA elsewhere along the course.

Registration and set-up will begin Friday afternoon, December 2nd. The event is expected to conclude by 3pm on December 5th. Racers will actually be on the described courses on Saturday from noon to 3:00pm. Approximately 500 participants are expected.








## What is a Common Council?

The Common Council consists of the elected alderpersons & the mayor. The Council is the legislative branch of city government. It sets the policy direction of the city through establishing ordinances (laws), passing resolutions, setting priorities and approving motions at public meetings.

The Council is responsible for setting the city budget, overseeing all city properties, and public services. It is responsible for setting tax rates and assessing fees to meet operational and contingency needs of the city. Council also has to approve all bonding, tax incentives for economic development and capital expenditures.

## What is the role of an alder?

- ⇒ Represent the interests of the their districts' constituents, as well as those of the entire city.
- ⇒ Set the city's policy direction, considering not only constituents' ideas, but also staff expertise and relevant evidence & data.
- ⇒ Cannot make unilateral decisions regarding official policy.
- ⇒ Serve as a link between district residents & the city in resolving issues, needs & complaints.
- ⇒ Communicate with residents using a variety of media.
- ⇒ Attend & participate in Common Council, committee and board meetings.
- ⇒ Fully participate in budget planning, including capital expenditures & bonding.
- ⇒ Submit proposals & initiatives for consideration by the Council.
- ⇒ Vote on mayoral vetoes.
- ⇒ Conduct themselves in a manner appropriate to the office.

## WI Statute 62.11(5)

### Powers of the Council

“Except as elsewhere in the statutes specifically provided, the council shall have the management and control of the city property, finances, highways, navigable waters, and the public service, and shall have power to act for the government and good order of the city, for its commercial benefit, and for the health, safety, and welfare of the public, and may carry out its powers by license, regulation, suppression, borrowing of money, tax levy, appropriation, fine, imprisonment, confiscation, and other necessary or convenient means. The powers hereby conferred shall be in addition to all other grants, and shall be limited only by express language.
