Hello John,

Please accept this message as a formal request to the City to close Main Street from Strongs Avenue to the Square on Friday, May 20th in the interest of safety. The Arts Alliance of Portage County will be conducting the annual event called ArtsWalk on that date. ArtsWalk is basically a three hour art fair running from **5 p.m. to 8 p.m.** Local artists are invited by downtown business owners to display their artwork in storefront windows and there are several performances planned for the sidewalk and other spaces. We are asking to close traffic on Main Street from 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 In the past we have not closed Main Street for ArtsWalk but this year we are expecting a considerable increase in the number of people attending this event. Given that people have a tendency to cross back and forth across Main Street to look at the displayed artwork, we are concerned about the safety of the event.

In addition to the fact that ArtsWalk has been growing gradually every year, this year an event we are calling 'The Mass Guitar Incident' is expected to draw several hundred more people to ArtsWalk. The Mass Guitar Incident is an invitation to everyone with an acoustic guitar to come together to play two songs in unison. All ages are encouraged to participate. We put out a call for 100 guitar players as a way to help people get the picture. We are beginning to think that we may actually exceed that number. We are hoping to hold the event on the street if we are able to close it. In years past numerous people suggested that we ask to close Main Street during ArtsWalk. This year the idea seems more appropriate than ever.

We hope to close the street at least two hours before the start of ArtsWalk. That would mean 3:00 p.m. Naturally some cars will be parked on the street at 3:00 p.m. but they will need to gone by 5:00p.m. I think. Additionally, some artists will need to unload their work at their display location. (Most will have already set up their displays in advance.) I have discussed this possibility with a limited number of downtown merchants who indicated they were in favor of the street closing.


Thank you for your consideration. It is my intention to attend the Public Protection Committee meeting on Monday May 9. and make myself available to answer any questions.



RE: United Way's Run, Bike, United Duathlon – Road Closing

In partnership with Sentry Insurance, United Way of Portage County would like to organize a second annual endurance event on Saturday, August 27 to kick off the fall fundraising campaign. We request approval from the Public Protection Committee to proceed with planning for this event.

The Run, Bike, United Duathlon would begin at 8:30 a.m. and features three separate stages—a 2-mile run, a 13-mile bike ride, and a final 2-mile run. A map of the proposed routes for each stage is enclosed. We anticipate most participants will complete the entire course in 1 ½ to 2 ½ hours.

To better facilitate the start/finish and transition areas and ensure participant safety, we would like to partially close a portion of Michigan Avenue for the duration of the event. Closing the southbound lane(s) of N Reserve St/ Michigan Ave N (*the lane(s) closest to the Sentry Home Office Building – opposite of the lane we asked to be closed last year*) from Eagle Summit Rd to Northpoint Drive on August 27 from 8 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. to give all participants enough time to finish. This would allow participants to start quickly and safely transition between stages while keeping the northbound lanes open and traffic in and out of SentryWorld unaffected.

We would be happy to send a representative to an upcoming Public Protection Committee meeting to discuss in further detail our plans for this community event. 

Proposed South bound lane closure for Duathlon in red below







