1. Discussion and Possible Action on the Recommendations on the License Lists:

A) New and Renewal Operator's (Bartender's) Licenses.

Ald. Wiza **moved**, Ald. Trzebiatowski seconded, approval of the 47 New and 95 Renewal Operator's Licenses.

B) Special Class "B" / "Class B" Retailer's Licenses:

i) Association of Downtown Businesses, 1245 Main St. Suite 200, for Corn on the Curb on August 5-6, 2011 at the downtown square.

ii) Stevens Point Area Catholic Schools, 1004 First St., for Panacea on Sept. 9-11, 2011 at Pacelli High School, 1301 Maria Drive.

Police Chief Ruder said the Department had no issues with the requests.

Ald. Trzebiatowski **moved**, Ald. Slowinski seconded, approval of the Special Class "B" / "Class B" Retailer's Licenses for the Association of Downtown Businesses' Corn on the Curb on August 5-6, 2011 at the downtown square and Stevens Point Area Catholic Schools, for Panacea on Sept. 9-11, 2011 at Pacelli High School, 1301 Maria Drive.

Troy Hojnacki believes this would be a good event to show off the downtown square. The event is in the infancy stage and they are seeking to get approval before moving forward.

Ald. Trzebiatowski and Ald. Brooks raised issues with the closing of the streets around the civic space.

Chief Ruder said the date of the event could not be any worse as it is also homecoming. He feels the Police Department will already be spread thin during that weekend. He stressed he did not have a problem with the event, but rather the date they want to do it on.

Troy Hojnacki feels this would be a good date to have the event because of the other events already taking place. He chose that weekend because it was homecoming.

Ald. Wiza agrees with Chief Ruder that the two large events occurring at the same time and people traveling between them does raise concerns.

Chief Ruder noted that even with the addition of contractual officers from the Sheriff's Department he feels it would really place a strain on the police force.

Ald. R. Stroik asked if they have the contractual officers or was that something just talked about.

Troy Hojnacki said he has not spoken to them yet about it.

Ald. R. Stroik noted that this was not put on the agenda last month to give the group time to work out the issues with the Police Department so the committee can make a decision.

Ald. Wiza likes the idea of the event but also shares the concerns of the lack of planning.

Mayor Halverson also wants to promote the downtown area; however, he shares the Police Department's concerns and feels that a different date would make the request workable.

Ald. R. Stroik **moved**, Ald. M. Stroik seconded, to postpone action for one month to allow the ADB and the Police Department time to work out the details.
