*Conditional Use*

1. Closing times to be in alignment with normal tavern operations in the city of Stevens Point. My competition has more hours they are open than we are. This is impeding our ability to maximize our business. Our customers are currently forced to leave my business and go to our competition. We have been operating for over 2 years with the limited hours and I firmly believe we have proven we are capable of operating without issues with the residential neighbors.

- a. Current hours of operation are Monday-Wednesday 4-midnight, Thursday – Sunday 11am-2:30am. This restriction was originally put in place to ensure we could operate in a fashion that did not disturb the neighborhood. I believe we have proven that.
- b. Request: 11am-2:30am 7 days a week.

2. October 22nd - Fusion Pro Wrestling fund raising event for Camp Heartland.

- a. Semi-pro wrestling event
- b. ~~Extended premise to include the sports center for a fundraising event. We had the same event with a premise extension in April 2011 without incident~~





Dear City Clerk,

The Association of Downtown Businesses (ADB) will once again be sponsoring the Annual Dozynki Harvest Festival on Friday, September 16th from 4pm-9pm on the Square and Saturday, September 17<sup>th</sup> 10am-9pm with activities throughout Downtown Stevens Point.

The ADB is requesting to put up a tent on the center of the Square on Friday morning. We would ask that "No Parking" signage be placed on the center portion of the Square on Thursday and that the entire Square be "No Parking" from 3pm-10pm on Friday and until 9pm on Saturday.

Additionally on Saturday, we request Main Street from Strongs Avenue to Water Street be closed from 6 am to 4 pm for street events. We would ask for no parking on Main Street until after 4 pm. Friday night's Square Activities will feature an outdoor Fish Boil with live Polish Bands. Saturday, food will be available on the Square from 11am- 9pm accompanied by music.

As the nature of the event celebrates the Harvest, we will be working with a way to involve the Farmer's Market Vendors on Saturday. While it would be optimal to the event to have the bollards moved to their outermost positions we recognize that may limit the ability of the vendors to participate in the event, which is not the desired effect. Conversations with the Farmer's Market Association will take place to assure that all parties benefit from this great downtown event.

Heritage of Portage County will be sponsoring both night's entertainment and beverage sales. We have submitted our request for a Special Call "B" Beer Retail License with the Clerk. Fencing will be set-up around the tent area for beer sales. Our organizations will continue to provide the following to ensure the safety and success of this event:

- Fencing following the natural outline of the buildings in the square to serve as the boundary for the event.

*The mission of the Association of Downtown Businesses is "to lead and engage the community in maximizing our historic Downtown Stevens Point."*

- Portable toilets will be provided and will be removed immediately following the event.
- The event will end at 9:00 pm on Friday evening and 9pm on Saturday.

As always, we will work with the Police Department to ensure the safety of visitors to our downtown during this event.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF  
STEVENS POINT, WISCONSIN**

The Common Council of the City of Stevens Point do ordain as follows:

**SECTION I:** That Section 12.14(18) of the Revised Municipal Code is hereby **amended** to read as follows:

(18) Applications Due. Applications for Class "B" picnic licenses must be made not less than ten (10) ~~four (4)~~ days prior to granting of the licenses. Applications for "Class B" temporary wine licenses must be made not less than fifteen (15) days prior to granting of the licenses.

**SECTION II:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
