B. UW Stevens Point Adventure Tours – Ciclovía Wisconsin event, on Sept. 22, 2012 with partial closures of Old Wausau Rd., DuBay Ave., Second St. North, Reserve St., North Point Dr., Michigan Ave. North, Maria Dr., Division St., Main St.

Trevor Roark, 601 Washington Avenue, gave a brief summary of the event.

Chief Ruder said the route is very difficult. He said there are concerns with the closure of some of the streets on the current route. The Chief stated the organizer was notified that they would be responsible for paying the officers.

Director Lemke was concerned with closing the main streets.

Mr. Roark said he was open to partial closures for the main streets.

Ald. Wiza asked why this route was chosen.

Mr. Roark said part of the purpose was to get people involved in seeing the commercial side of the city.

Mayor Halverson asked that the route be modified to keep it off of Main and Division Streets.

Ald. R. Stroik **moved**, Ald. Wiza seconded, to postpone action until the next Public Protection meeting and ask that the applicant work with the Police Department and other department heads to come up with a better route that would be less detrimental to the City.
