April 14<sup>th</sup> – Country Jam USA is hosting a live remote radio broadcast with Muzzy Broadcasting and Tuscan Road the country band will be playing in the sports center. We will serve beer and alcohol in the sports center for this event. This is an age 21+ event. All entrances will be manned. Neighbors will be notified by postcard in the mail of the upcoming event at Players' Lounge. All neighbors will be given free admittance to the show via the postcard. The show will run from 9pm-midnight. We anticipate the noise level to be far less than experienced at Brews Brats and Bands or River Front Rendezvous, both of which abut heavily populated residential areas.

April 27<sup>th</sup> – National celebrity Hal Sparks will be performing a comedy show in the sports center from 7:30-9pm, and his band will perform from 9:30pm – midnight. 
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**PORTAGE COUNTY CERTIFIED SURVEY MAP**

RE: CAP Services' **Take a Step 5K** run/walk for Family Crisis Center

CAP Services requests approval for the 10<sup>th</sup> annual Take A Step 5K run/walk fundraiser for the Family Crisis Center. The event will take place on Tuesday, July 17th at 6:00 pm at the UWSP's Allen Center on Illinois Ave. The route will remain the same as in the past: traveling Illinois Avenue north to Maria Drive; Maria Drive east to Michigan Avenue; and, then north on Michigan Avenue through North Point Drive to a turn-around just before DuBay Avenue with the return on the same route.

CAP Services is requesting:

- road closing of Illinois Avenue from Maria Drive to the UWSP Parking Lot Q for the duration of the event (4pm to 7pm)
- no parking along Illinois Avenue from Maria Drive to Lot Q
- no parking on Maria Drive from Illinois Avenue to Michigan Avenue
- the use of traffic cones on Maria Drive and Michigan Avenue to designate route, and,
- use of part of the roadway for the race route.

The event is a collaborative effort between the National Wellness Conference and CAP Services. A sufficient number of volunteers are recruited to assist participants along the course. The Stevens Point Police Department provides reflective vests to be worn by volunteers during the event. This is the 10th annual "Take a Step 5K" and we are estimating the number of participants to be approximately 500. We believe this event is manageable with the number of volunteers we are recruiting.

The Family Crisis Center provides emergency shelter and a variety of support and advocacy services to victims of domestic and sexual assault. The theme for the event is "Take a Step 5K." We believe that communities working together can "take a step" to help end family violence.


Here is the information that you asked for regarding the application to consider approval for our event. The Walk for Hope – Run for Awareness is being organized by Healthy People Portage County – Suicide Prevention and Mental Health Awareness Committee. The event will be held on Saturday, September 8, 2012 in the parking lot of Ministry Health Services, 2501 Main Street, Stevens Point. The event coincides with National Suicide Prevention Week. This is the seventh year for the Walk for Hope which provides registrants an opportunity to participate in a 2 mile or 5 mile walk. New to our event this year is a 5-K Fun Run.

Registration for the 5-K Fun Run will be held at Ministry Health Services, 2501 Main Street. Registration is planned for 7:00 AM with the run beginning at 8:00 AM. We expect to have all runners back by 9:30 AM – if not sooner. The proposed route goes south of Clark Street (3.09 miles). Participants would start on Chase Street then they would take Ellis Street (runners would be in a large group at this time), to Michigan Ave, to Dixon Street (Dixon becomes Ridgewood Drive), to Greenbrier, to 66 (but not having to cross it and by that time runners will begin to thin out), then back to Ellis, and back to the starting point on Chase Street.

We plan to have Stevens Point Officers on hand to help control traffic at major intersections such as Chase/Ellis, Ellis/Michigan, Michigan/Dixon, Greenwood/Main (66), Minnesota/Main. Possible road closures for the event may include: Chase for entire time of the run, intersection of Ellis/Michigan (at the start of the run), Jefferson/Michigan (at the start of the run), Minnesota/Dixon, Jefferson/Greenbrier. Minor or less traveled roads will be patrolled by volunteers. Our group has spoken with Tim Davy of the Stevens Point Police Department who is helping us work out additional details regarding logistics. Please see the attached map for additional information regarding the route for the run.

Being the first year of the 5-K event we expect to have at least 100 participants. In addition, we typically have around 200 participants for the walk. We do carry of certificate of insurance for the event through Portage County and will have all participants sign a waiver of liability and injury. We look forward to working with the City of Stevens Point to provide a safe and enjoyable event for our participants. 
