**1. Recommendations on the License List:**

**A. New Operator's (Bartender's) Licenses.**

Ald. Trzebiatowski **moved**, Ald. Slowinski seconded, to approve item 1A. 19 new operator licenses.

Call for the vote: Ayes, all; nays, none; motion carried. Ald. Wiza abstained.

- B. Reserve "Class B" Combination beer & liquor license for CHP of Stevens Point, 3280 Thompson Ct., Stevens Point, WI at Father Fats Public House, 945 Clark Street, Stevens Point, WI; Christian Czerwonka, agent.**
- C. Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverage and Class "C" Wine for Wendy Cliver for Heritage Pub, 929 Main Street, Stevens Point; for license period beginning April 17, 2012.**
- D. Temporary Class "B" / "Class B" Retailer's License (Picnic License) for Stevens Point Area Catholic Schools, 1004 First Street, for Panacea on September 7-9, 2012 at Pacelli High School, 1301 Maria Drive. Licensed operator on the premise: Ken Raflik.**

Ald. Trzebiatowski **moved**, Ald. Wiza seconded, to approve item 1B. Reserve "Class B" combination beer and liquor license for CHP of Stevens Point at Father Fats Public House, 945 Clark Street with Christian Czerwonka as agent, item 1C. Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverage and Class "C" Wine for Wendy Cliver for Heritage Pub, 929 Main Street, Stevens Point; for license period beginning April 17, 2012 and 1D. Picnic license for Stevens Point Area Catholic Schools, 1004 First Street, for Panacea on September 7-9, 2012 at Pacelli High School with Ken Raflik as the licensed operator.

Ald. Brooks asked how many reserve liquor licenses does the City has.

Clerk Moe explained how many licenses the City has and how they were acquired. He said the City currently has 55 liquor licenses.

Ald. Brooks asked if a Reserve license is more costly.

Clerk Moe replied a Reserve license has a one time fee of \$10,000.

Ald. Wiza **moved**, Ald. Slowinski seconded, to approve the temporary extension of licensed premise for Jason J. Glisczynski, 1920 Adams Street, Plover, WI at Player's Lounge, 2124 Rice Street, request for temporary extension of licensed premise to include the sports center area for special events on April 14 and April 27, 2012 and temporary extension of licensed premise to include the sports center area and fenced in tent area on the north end of the building attached to the north exit doors to the sports center for special events on May 19 and July 20, 2012.

Ald. Trzebiatowski asked why this is being presented at such a late date.

Clerk Moe said the request did not come in until March 21, 2012.

Ald. Trzebiatowski said he is concerned if these requests can be properly evaluated with such short notice.

Asst. Chief Skibba said the Police Department reviewed the request and the request is similar to events that have been held in the past.

Ald. R. Stroik asked if the Police Department has any issues with this request.

Asst. Chief Skibba replied no.

Jason Glisczynski, 1920 Adams Street, said the request was submitted late because he was first approached on March 20 for the event on April 14. Mr. Glisczynski said he is available for any further questions.

Ald. R. Stroik asked if the neighbors were notified.

Jason Glisczynski said he was first waiting for approval.

**Clerk Moe said anyone within 200' of the premise was notified of this request.**

Ald. R. Stroik asked if there was anyone in the audience that wished to speak.
