- The Forestry Department is planting trees and preparing for the Arbor Day planting scheduled for Saturday, May 5<sup>th</sup> at Iverson Park at 10:00 a.m.
- Usage at Goerke Community Stadium is up. Used by UW-SP with football and soccer, SPASH for track meets and the YMCA for youth football.
- The entrance road(hill) into Iverson Park off Jefferson Street (Hillcrest) will be reconstructed in the next month or two.
- A group asked to use the Skateboard Park for a fundraiser. Director Schrader recommended that they work the Skateboard Park Committee since the Skateboard Park Committee is still trying to raise funds for their commitment.
- Director Schrader reported that Woodlands Church held their clean-up day in the parks again this past Saturday. A big thank-you on behalf of the Parks Department.
- Commissioner Hall asked that everyone remember that the Audubon **Society's** annual bird watching event will be held on Saturday, May 5<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. at Iverson Park prior to the Arbor Day tree planting event.
- Alderperson Wiza stated that they had a successful clean-up day at the Dog Park and have made some minor improvements to the park.
