RE: United Way's Run, Bike, United Duathlon – Road Closing

In partnership with Sentry Insurance, United Way of Portage County is organizing its third annual endurance event on Saturday, August 25 to kick off the fall fundraising campaign. We request approval from the Public Protection Committee to proceed with planning for this event.

The Run, Bike, United Duathlon would begin at 8:30 a.m. and features three separate stages—a 2-mile run, a 13-mile bike ride, and a final 2-mile run. A map of the proposed routes for each stage is enclosed. We anticipate most participants will complete the entire course in 1 ½ to 2 ½ hours.

To better facilitate the start/finish and transition areas and ensure participant safety, we would like to partially close a portion of Michigan Avenue for the duration of the event. Closing the southbound lane(s) of N Reserve St/ Michigan Ave N (*the lane(s) closest to the Sentry Home Office Building – the same lane we requested to be closed last year*) from Eagle Summit Rd to Northpoint Drive on August 25 from 8 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. to give all participants enough time to finish. This would allow participants to start quickly and safely transition between stages while keeping the northbound lanes open and traffic in and out of SentryWorld unaffected.

We would be happy to send a representative to an upcoming Public Protection Committee meeting to discuss in further detail our plans for this community event. The Special Olympics Summer Games will once again be held in Stevens Point, Thursday, June 7th through Saturday, June 9th, 2012. This year commemorates the 40th Anniversary of Special Olympics Wisconsin.

As in years past, police officers from across the state are participating in the Law Enforcement Torch Run and will converge in Stevens Point on the afternoon of June 7th to show their support for the Special Olympics athletes by carrying the Olympic flame to the games.

We are again requesting to hold a parade to honor the hard work and dedication of our local athletes. The parade would begin at approximately 5:30 PM on Thursday, June 7th from the staging area in the 1100 Block of Crosby Avenue.

The proposed route would be as follows:

- East on Crosby Avenue to Water Street
- North on Water Street/Second Street to Fourth Avenue
- East on Fourth Avenue to Reserve Street
- North on Reserve Street to the Coleman Track

In addition to Torch Runners, the parade will consist of police and fire vehicles, one or more floats and support vehicles. It is anticipated that it will take no longer than 10 minutes for the parade to pass any one location. The route may be subject to minor alteration dependent on traffic activity.

Traffic control at intersections will be handled by on-duty officers as well as a sufficient number of volunteers to insure the City incurs no additional manpower costs.

Should any additional reasonable traffic restrictions become necessary as planning for this event develops, a Mayoral order will be sought. The Police Department anticipates no difficulty with accommodating this request.

(e) No person, association or corporation may operate after a permit suspension or revocation unless the suspension is released in writing or the revocation is not upheld by the Public Protection Committee or court.

(9) Permits and Identifying Devices Not Transferable. Permits and permit identifying devices shall be nontransferable except upon order of the City Clerk. Any food peddler selling, giving away or exchanging any permit or permit identifying device, or any food peddler obtaining a permit by misrepresentation, or improperly registering their name or address shall be subject to the fines provided for in sub.(15).

(10) Prohibited and Required Acts.

(a) A food peddler shall not:

1. Sell food between the hours of 3:00A.M. and 6:00 A.M. the following morning. This prohibition shall not apply during any other specific hours specified by the Common Council by resolution.

2. Block or restrict an individual's access to a business or residential doorway.

3. Block or restrict pedestrians on the public way.

4. Make any comment, request, suggestion or proposal which is obscene, lewd, lascivious, profane, filthy or indecent.

5. Sell food door-to-door, except for non-profit organizations, as defined under Section 12.25 Direct Sellers/Transient Merchants.

(b) A food peddler shall:

1. Make all sales on the public way directly from a pushed, pedaled, pulled, or motorized vehicle or a carried container.

2. Keep all perishable foods in one of the following ways:

a. Frozen.

b. Refrigerated at 40 degrees F or lower by means of mechanical refrigeration.

c. Heated and maintained at 150 degrees F.
