## Rider's Guide



### Bus Fares

**Cash** You must have the exact fare. Drivers do not carry change. Have your payment ready when you board.

**Passes** \* You can purchase passes at Trig's, Shopko and Sav-A-Lot.

**Transfers** If you need to use more than one bus to reach your destination, ask your driver for a Transfer. Transfers are free, but should be requested when you arrive at the Transfer Center. Transfers are valid within the half hour time limit.

### Discounted Fares

**Seniors and Persons with Disabilities**  
To receive a reduced fare, seniors (age 65 and over) and persons with disabilities must show a valid Medicare card or present a Stevens Point Transit reduced fare card. For additional information or to request a reduced fare application, call 715-341-4490.

**Children** Any child aged five (5) and under can ride the bus FREE when accompanied by a paying adult. Groups excluded.

**Organized Groups** Groups such as daycares or pre-kindergarten classes receive their return trip FREE. Adults in the group pay both ways.

**MSTC Students** To receive the discounted rate, students must show their valid MSTC ID when boarding the bus.

**U-Pass Program** UWSP students can ride all SPT buses for FREE. The cost is included in student fees and tuition. Students must show their valid UWSP Point Card when boarding the bus.

### Accessibility and Other Services

All our buses are equipped with mobility device ramps. People who do not use a mobility device but are unable to climb the step can request to have the bus lowered.

**Plover Connection**  
To arrange transport to the Plover area contact Plover Taxi at 715-342-1313. Specific transfer points are established near the BP station on Tommy's Turnpike and at Crossroads Commons.

**Request-Only Routes**  
Routes indicated by dashed lines on the map are request-only.  
**For Pick-Up:** Call the Transit Office 15 minutes before your requested pick-up time. You must be at the stop when the bus arrives. The bus will not wait for you.  
**For Drop-Off:** Inform the bus driver when you board the bus.

**Bikes on the Bus**  
Racks for bikes are located on the front of the bus. Space is available for up to two bikes on a first-come, first-served basis. Motorized and tandem bikes are not permitted on racks.  
Bikes are not permitted inside the bus. If the bike rack is full, passengers with bikes must take the next scheduled bus.

**Loading your bike:**  
1. Squeeze the handle up to release the latch, then fold down rack.  
2. Lift bike onto rack placing front wheel into labeled slot.  
3. Raise support arm up and over tire so the hook rests at the highest point on the front wheel.

**Unloading your bike:**  
1. Raise support arm off tire and fold it down securely.  
2. Lift bike out of the rack.  
3. Squeeze handle and fold up the rack.  
4. Step away from the bus and move to the curb.  
Allow the bus to proceed before crossing the street.

### Point Plus Paratransit Service

If your disability prevents you from using the City Bus, you may qualify to use our Point Plus paratransit service. This door-to-door service is available during regular hours Monday through Friday and Saturdays when UWSP is in full session. Point Plus must certify your eligibility for participation.

### Rider Guidelines

- Study the bus map and find out which bus route serves the area you want to go.
- Go to a nearby bus stop sign five minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive.
- When the bus arrives, wait for departing passengers to get off before boarding. Have your exact fare or bus pass ready when boarding. Drivers do not carry change.
- If your trip requires the use of more than one bus, ask the driver for a transfer slip when departing the first bus. A transfer must be used no later than one trip after it is issued and must be used to continue your trip on a different route.
- When the bus is about one block from your bus stop, signal the driver by pulling the bell cord above the window. Remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop. Wait until the bus has pulled away before crossing the street.

**Seating Priorities**  
Please allow seniors and persons with disabilities to use the front facing seats. These seats also fold up to become a wheelchair safety securement area. You may be asked to vacate the securement area in order for us to accommodate a person boarding in a wheelchair.

**Lost and Found**  
SPT is not responsible for lost items. However, if you lose something while riding the city bus, report it as soon as possible by calling the Stevens Point Transit Office at 715-341-4490.

### Bus Rules: + Do's and x Don'ts

- + Use headphones/earbuds when listening to music
- + Wear shoes, shirts while on the bus
- + Keep feet off seats, seat backs and walls
- + Keep aisles clear of packages, strollers, etc.
- x Don't leave your child in the stroller
- x Don't eat, drink, smoke or chew tobacco
- x Don't use loud or offensive language
- x Animals not allowed (except service animals)

**NOTE: Drivers may ask riders who do not follow these rules to get off the bus.**
