

Last bus leaves Water & Main at 2:55am.


EAST ROUTE

Get On Board

You can get on the bus at any stop along the routes. To board, stand next to the stop on the right side of the street.

While You're Aboard

For your safety, all of our buses are equipped with cameras inside and outside of the bus.

Drivers reserve the right to refuse service if riders appear to be a potential danger to others, themselves, or would impede the bus service in any way.

Rules to Ride

- No food or drinks allowed
- No smoking or chewing tobacco
- No use of loud or offensive language
- Do not put feet on seats or seat backs
