# WHAT IS I.S.I.?

ISI stands for "Ice Skating Institute" and was developed in 1961. ISI is a recreational program used worldwide and has been developed for those who skate for recreation and enjoyment. The program objective is to develop good skating skills, and encourage people to skate more often.

## DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES AND SKILLS DEVELOPED

- Pre-Tot (Age 3): Introduction to skating for 3 year olds only. Fun, balance, and self-confidence are stressed. The child will learn how to stand, fall, and get up by themselves. Then skills will progress to marching and gliding on 2 feet.
- Tot 1 (Ages 4-6): Beginning class for 4-6 year olds. The child is instructed to stand, fall and get up by themselves. Pushing with each foot and 2 foot glides are taught, as well as forward and backward wiggles.
- Tot 2 (Ages 4-6): Skater should be able to push with each foot to excel to this level. One-foot glides are taught as well as forward and backward swizzles.
- (Ages 7+)  
Pre-Alpha: Skater is instructed on how to fall and get up correctly. One-foot glides are taught as well as forward and backward swizzles.
- (Ages 7+)  
Alpha: This class is for the skater who has accomplished one-foot glides on each foot. Forward stroking, forward crossovers and the snowplow stops are also taught.
- Beta: Backward skating is perfected here. Backward stroking, backward crossovers and T-stops are also taught at this level.
- Gamma: Mohawks, outside 3 turns, and hockey stops are taught. Oftentimes, the Gamma and Delta skaters work together due to the similarity in elements.
- Delta: Inside 3 turns, forward edge rolls, lunges, tap toes, and shoot the duck are taught.
- Pre-Freestyle/  
Freestyle 1: This class is for those who have mastered the basic skills of skating as described above. Waltz jumps, 1-foot spins, backward edge rolls and forward spirals are some of the skills taught at this level.
- Stars on Ice: This class is for the freestyle skater. Skaters are placed into groups where skills from Freestyle 1 through 5 will be taught These Include Jumps, Spins, and footwork Elements.
- Artistic/Power/Moves: This class is geared toward Freestyle 1 skaters and higher. Each week we will do something different. Artistic will improve skating to music. Power skating will improve speed. Moves will improve edges.
- Adult: Adults will work at their own pace in a non-structured atmosphere.
- Off Ice Strength, Poise, and Conditioning:  
This class is open to Gamma, Delta, and all Freestyle skaters. Class will involve off ice exercises focusing on improving muscle strength and flexibility along with incorporating ballet techniques into skating.

# REGISTRATION

1. Fill out the registration form with your class selection.
2. Enclose a check made payable to the K.B. Willett Arena for the total fee.
3. Read, sign, and enclose the waiver with registration form. (Waiver located on reverse side of registration form).

## SPRING 2019 ICE SHOW GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Ice Show will be held on Saturday **March 30<sup>th</sup>** and Sunday **March 31<sup>st</sup>** of **2019**.
- The Spring Ice Skating show is a themed presentation hosted by the Stevens Point Parks Department and the Crystal Ice Figure Skating Club. We have three shows. Two shows will be held on Saturday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, one at 2:00 pm and one at 7:00 pm. The third show will be held on Sunday, March 31<sup>st</sup> at 2:00 pm.
- The Ice Show is not just for Freestyle skaters but also Tots, Pre-Alphas, Alphas, Betas, Gammas, Deltas, and Synchronized teams.
- To participate in the Ice Show you must be an **active member of the Crystal Ice Figure Skating Club or enrolled in the January 2019 Winter Session of the Learn to Skate Program**. Winter Learn to Skate registration must accompany the Ice Show Costume form.
- An Ice Show costume registration form will be located in the Fall session Learn to Skate brochure. The Fall session will begin on Saturday, October 20<sup>th</sup>. Registration for the Winter (January) session and the Ice Show will begin at the end of November. **The Costume Registration Form will be due Monday, December 3<sup>rd</sup>, No Exceptions and No Refunds.**
- There is an additional cost to participate in the Spring Ice Show. This cost covers the costume cost for each skater and rehearsal ice times. Ice rehearsal times will be posted on the bulletin board at the ice rink as well as mailed out approximately mid-February.
