Ron Ligman, Co-Chair of Dozynki Harvest Festival, said the fenced area will not affect any of the traffic area around the square. He added that there will be a road block at Grubba Jewelry.

**D. Temporary Extension of Licensed Premise: Jason J. Glisczynski, 1920 Adams Street, Plover, WI at Player's Lounge, 2124 Rice Street, request for temporary extension of licensed premise to include the sports center area for special events on October 20, 2012, November 9, 2012 and July 20, 2013.**

Jason Glisczynski, 1920 Adams Street, stated these events are similar to events that have been held in the past.

Ald. Trzebiatowski asked how approving an event for next summer plays out with Mr. Glisczynski only having a six month license.

Clerk Moe responded that the Plan Commission delayed making a decision on the July 20, 2013 event. The Clerk said it is up to the Council to decide how to handle it.

Ald. Wiza believes that these are temporary extensions of premise so if Mr. Glisczynski does not have his license renewed then he would not have a premise to extend.

City Attorney Molepske replied that is correct.

Ald. Wiza asked if the Player's Lounge is currently in compliance with all his conditional uses.

Director Ostrowski replied yes.

Ald. Wiza asked if there have been any police calls to this establishment.

Asst. Chief Skibba said there are no issues.

Ald. Wiza **moved**, Ald. Slowinski seconded, approval of the temporary extension of licensed premise for Jason Glisczynski at Player's lounge for special events on October 20, 2012, November 9, 2012 and July 20, 2013 as requested.

Barb Jacob, 1616 Depot Street, noted the event in July is for a class reunion. She said Mr. Glisczynski needs to make these requests early so he can give these people an answer.
