The Smongeski Health Fund has been operated through the City Clerk's office for the past 34 years. The following statistics cover the period from August 1, 2014 through July 31, 2015.

The Fund currently has over 80 families signed up for assistance in addition to providing financial support to other programs such as Healthy Smiles, Maternal and Child Health, and Project Fresh Start programs.

This year 42 children received vitamins and/or toothbrushes through our partnership with Shopko. This is a decline from last year, though several families do utilize the Fund more than once a year. In an effort to boost participation, we will be sending reminders out to participants later this year.

The number of students receiving sealants slightly increased this year as compared to last year. Healthy Smiles assisted 45 students with 163 sealants this year with the Fund covering the cost of 150 of those sealants. We did not receive any requests for reimbursement for sealants from dentists this year.

We had one request for assistance with eyeglasses which we were able to provide.
