2. Request to Hold Event/Street Closings:

A. Stevens Point Brewery – Annual Pointoberfest and 5K Blubber Run on September 17, 2016. Request for closure of sections of Water Street.

Chief Skibba said this is an annual event. He requested that two contractual officers be hired for the event.

Ald. McComb **moved**, Ald. Ryan seconded, to approve the Pointoberfest and 5K Blubber Run including the requirement that two officers are contracted for the event.

***B. Association of Downtown Businesses – Corn on the Curb on August 6, 2016 – Downtown Square with street closure of portions of Main Street and Second Street.**

Chief Skibba noted this is an annual event and in the past, there was the requirement for two contractual officers.

Ald. Morrow **moved**, Ald. Dugan seconded, to approve the Association of Downtown Businesses – Corn on the Curb on August 6, 2016 with two contractual officers and the street closings.

Ald. Johnson stated this is being introduced to engage members in bringing forward topics for discussion or educational ideas.

Ald. Ryan said issues he is concerned with are speed limits on major arteries, traffic control measures and house parties.

Mayor Wiza said this is a great idea. He reminded the alderpersons and anyone else that topics can be brought to the attention of a committee chair at any time.

Ald. Morrow stated the Riverfront Rendezvous was a success without a lot of issues.
