RE: Request to produce the Stevens Point Area YMCA Point Duathlon – Saturday, July 15, 2017, at 8:30am.  
(Nonprofit event fundraiser for the Stevens Point Area YMCA)

Our race is planned and implemented by the Stevens Point Area YMCA and is staged from Illinois Avenue in front of the Allen Center on UWSP campus. The run will not deviate from prior years, and consist of roads and paths on UWSP campus, Schmeckle Reserve, and surrounding areas. Bicycle routes take participants through the townships of Hull & Dewey. Registration and set-up will begin Friday afternoon, July 14<sup>th</sup>, and the event is expected to conclude by 12:00pm on Saturday, July 15<sup>th</sup>. Racers will be on the described courses on Saturday from 8:30 – 11:00am. Approximately 400 participants are expected.

Traffic control and aid is provided by volunteers, the Town of Hull Fire Department, HAM Radio, and possibly by the Portage Country Sheriff's Department on the bike course, and by volunteers and the Stevens Point Police and Auxilliary Police on the run courses. Traffic control takes the form of handheld stop/slow paddles provide by Portage Country Sheriff's Department. To help ensure participant safety, we are requesting to close Illinois Avenue between Maria Drive and Stanley Street, Maria Drive between Michigan Avenue and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and Michigan Avenue, between Northpoint Drive and Stanley Avenue to vehicular traffic. Volunteers serve at all intersections. I have attached course maps for your reference.

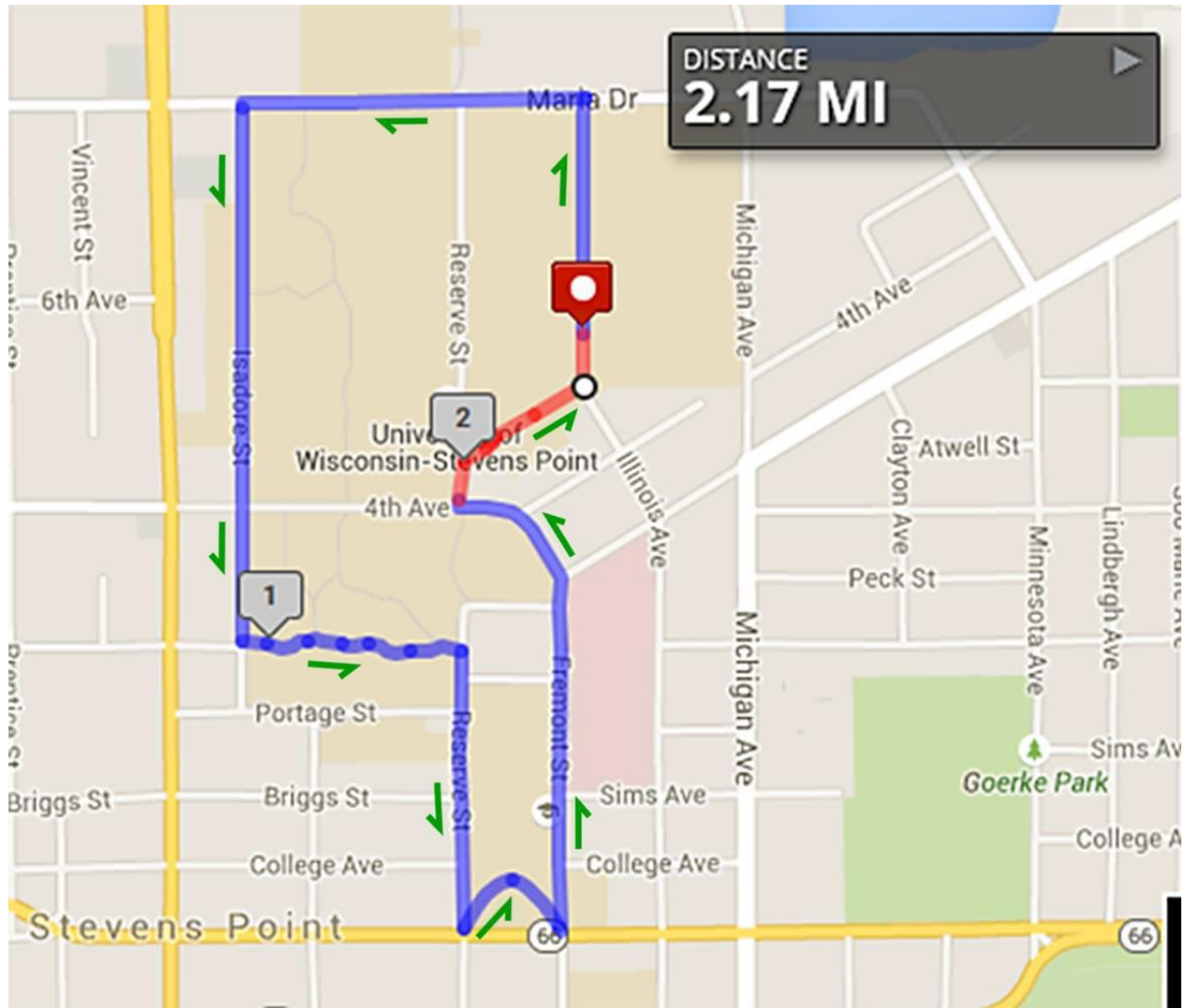

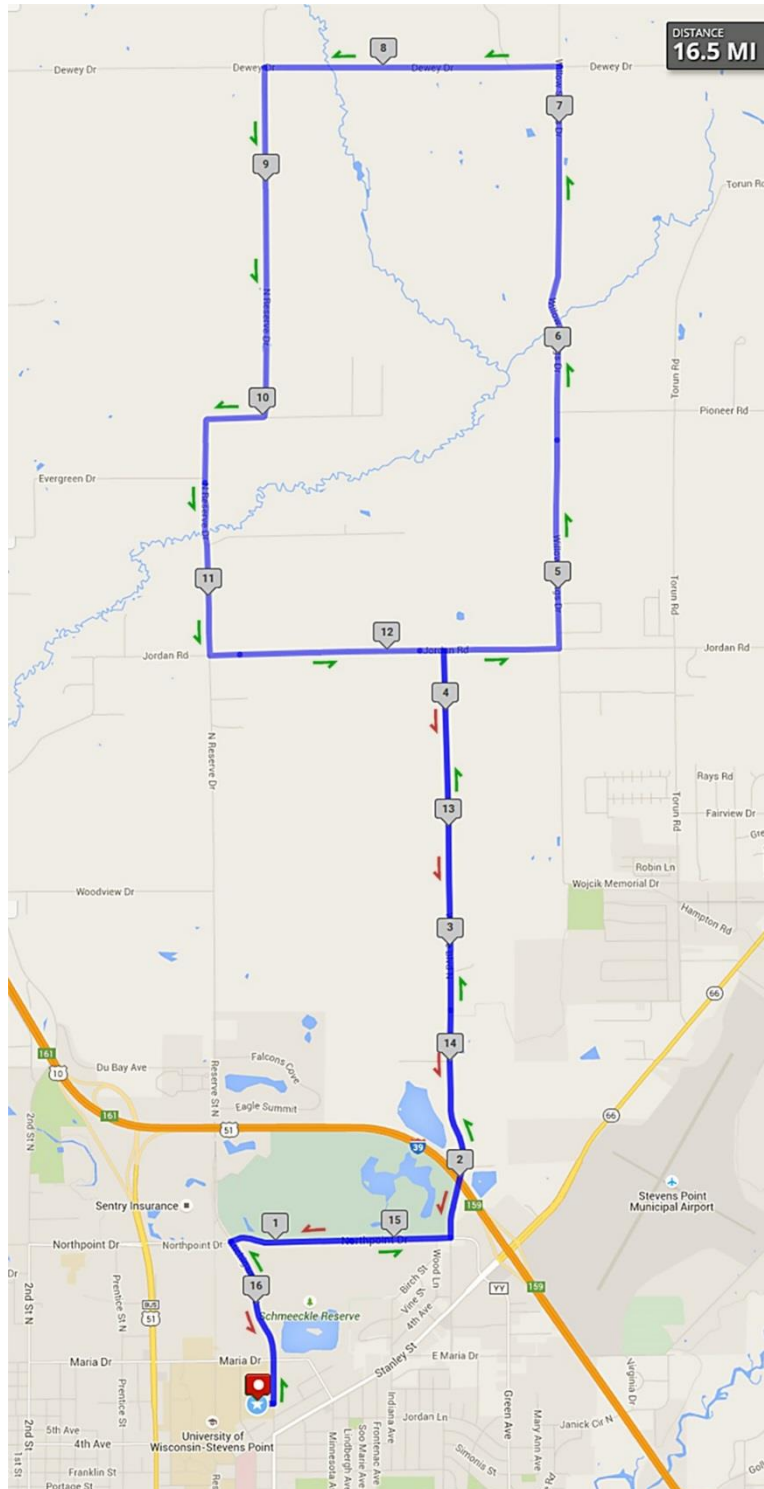

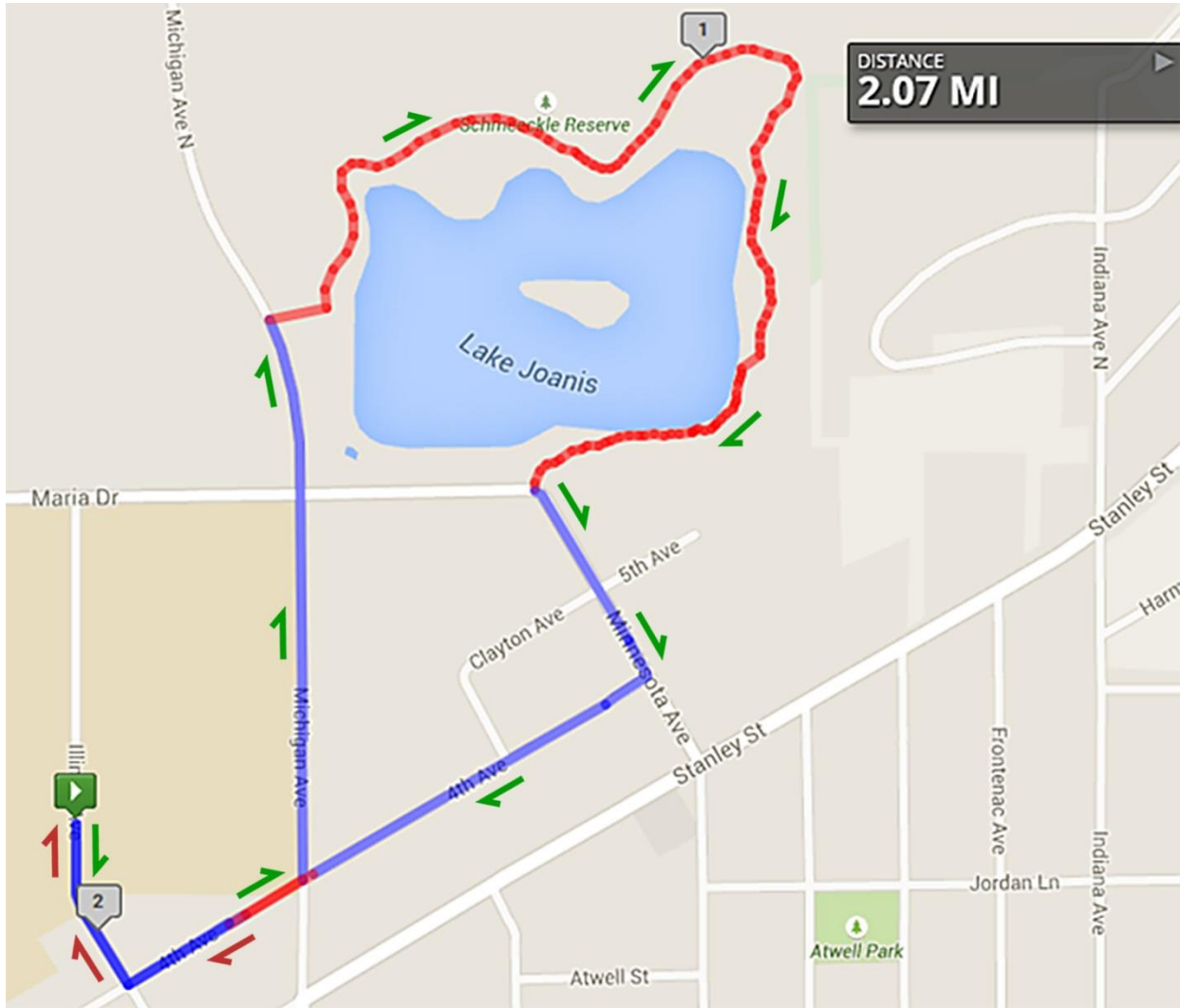

(Nonprofit event fundraiser for the Stevens Point Area YMCA)

Our race is planned and implemented by the Stevens Point Area YMCA and is staged from Lot Q on UWSP Campus. The proposed children's bike course route is mapped below. Kids ages 7-9 will bike one lap and ages 10-12 will bike two laps.

Traffic control and aid is provided by volunteers on the bike course. Traffic control takes the form of handheld stop/slow signs provided by the Stevens Point Sheriff's Department. As was done last year, we request closure of one lane of traffic (the lane closest to the sidewalk) for the duration of the race around the entire bike course. We learned in 2015 that kids are not able to remain on the sidewalks at all times, and oncoming traffic posed a threat to their safety. The race begins at 6:00pm, and will finish by 7:00pm. The kids' run course is located on the intramural field, so no road closure is necessary for that.

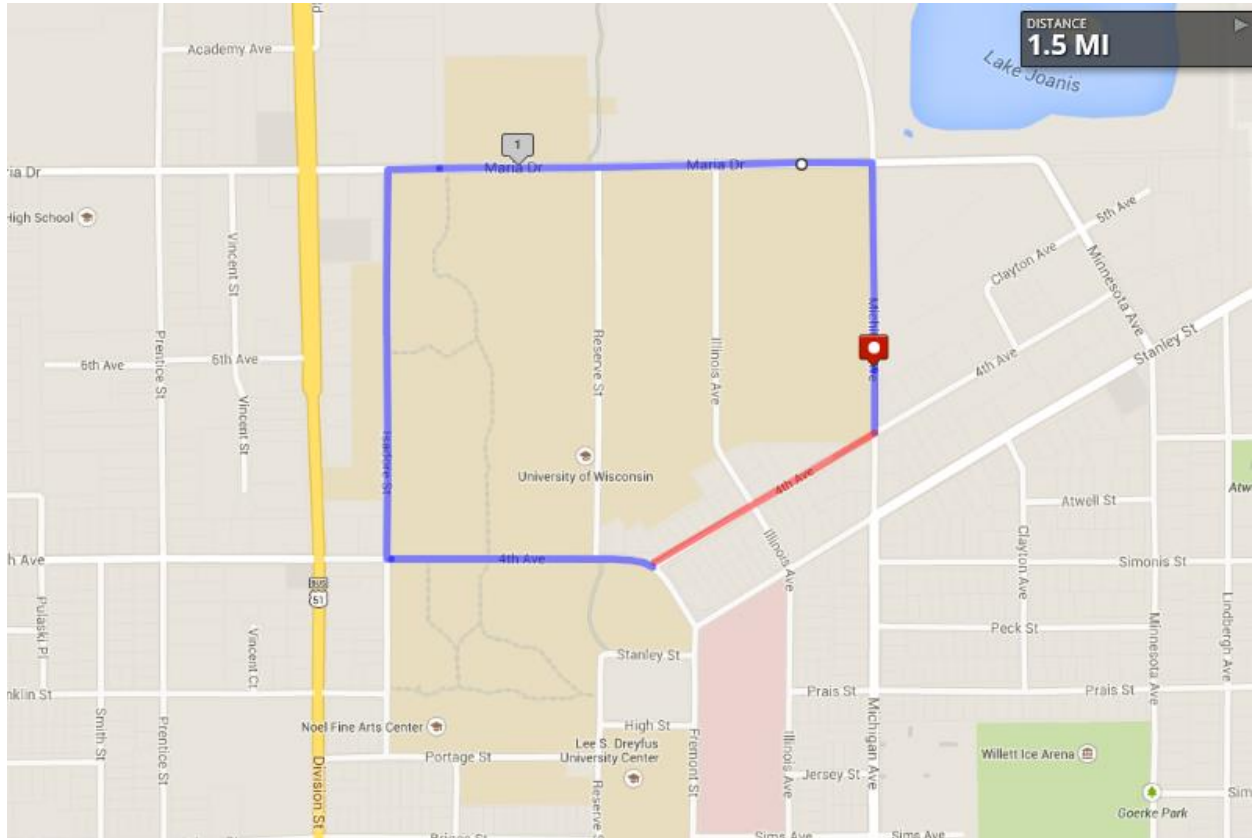

We are again asking permission to hold a Trivia Parade prior to the 2017 Trivia Contest on WWSP 90FM radio. We will again be registering teams in advance at the 90FM studios, and will ask Trivia teams to be in the parade on April 21. We would like to start the parade at 4:00 P.M. in the parking lot on Illinois Avenue (lot Q). The route that the parade would follow would be the same as last year, it follows:

Illinois avenue north to Maria Drive, Turn left.  
West on Maria Drive to Isadore Street, Turn left.  
South on Isadore Street to Portage Street, Turn left.  
East on Portage Street to Phillips Street, Turn right.  
South on Phillips Street to College Avenue, Turn left.  
East on College Street to Reserve, Turn left.  
North on Reserve to High Street, Turn right.  
East on High to Fremont Street, Turn right.  
South on Fremont to Simms Avenue, Turn left.  
East on Simms into the P.J. Jacobs parking lot.

First off, thank you both for your help in planning this event. It's our desire to offer an enjoyable, family-friendly event for our community and the possibility of having the downtown square as the venue is just great! Here are some specifics of the event:

- August 13th, 6pm-7pm - plus time for set-up and sound check (<2hrs) and take-down (1hr)
- Modern gospel music from Blake & Jenna Bolerjack ([blakebolerjack.com](http://blakebolerjack.com)) sponsored by Berea Baptist of Stevens Point
- Sound equipment w/amplification will be used
- 110v outlet required
- Approximately 100 folding chairs will be brought and utilized
- When we have hosted this couple for concerts in the past, we've had less than 100 people attend. For an outdoor concert, we would anticipate a larger turnout than that, but how much larger could only be speculated.
- We may hand out information about the church (if permitted)
- The Bolerjacks would also like to have a table set up for CD sales.
- We will not be serving food or beverage of any kind
- We will not be setting up any tents
- We do not anticipate any added security being necessary and will not need any streets blocked.
