- Ald. Jennings inquired about the bike racks at Mead and they should be installed by the end of next week
- Storm damage was severe especially in Iverson Park, almost 100 trees lost. Our crews along with the DNR have been working on trees. Zblewski Brothers were contracted with to handle the trees in the center of Iverson Park which were too dangerous to handle without his type of equipment. 75 or 80 city trees were lost.
- Schrader stated that he was questioned about the rezoning request before Plan Commission tonight for the old Kulas property. He said that he wasn't aware of the rezoning request until Friday of last week, and had shared with Director Ostrowski he was opposed to the rezoning. Several Commissioners stated that they were also opposed to the rezoning.
- Request to have a public thank you to all of the sponsors for the free/open swims at the municipal pool.
