DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS REPORT

1. Engineering Division

- **Sidewalk project – filling the gaps**
 - Contracts are being prepared and executed for work to be completed this summer.
- **Business 51 (Division Street) and North Point Drive Roundabout**
 - Engineering staff is working with the contractor and making arrangements for the completion of pavement markings which will be completed in the summer.
- **Stanley Street Improvements:**
 - Engineering staff continues to review the project with the Streets Department staff to create a traffic control plan, order materials and evaluate project limits.
 - AECOM has been retained to provide engineering services related to the evaluation of the intersection at Stanley and Green. AECOM will also be providing review of design elements and assistance with the creation of a traffic control plan for the lane reconfiguration.
- **TAP Grant**
 - SEH continues to work on environmental documentation and design elements of the project. Traffic modeling continues at signalized intersections. Railroad coordination is also under way. SEH has identified that they will be requesting a small change order to cover the cost of a historical review necessary to complete the requirements of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
- **East Park Commerce Center**
 - Ruckert Mielke is working on revising elements of the existing storm water system before finalizing a bid package for the infrastructure improvement project. The project is currently being planned for an early 2020 construction start.
- **Full Depth Joint Repair**
 - The Engineering Department is currently evaluating potential future projects in the downtown area. The implementation of any additional projects will, however, be dependent upon the recommendations of the Redevelopment Authority's downtown master planning effort.

- **2019 Roadway Improvements**
 - The Engineering Department continues to prepare for 2019 and 2020 reconstruction and resurfacing projects.
 - The following projects have been advertised for bidding:
 - Fifth Avenue and Pulaski Place (Second Avenue to Franklin Street)
 - The bid opening is scheduled for March 7th so the results are not known as of the writing of this report.
 - Reserve Street (Ellis Street to Dixon Street)
 - Bids were received on March 5. A total of 4 bids were received. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Jakes Excavating and Landscaping, LLC out of Ironwood, Michigan in the amount of \$672,986.33.
 - The following projects are still in design:
 - Whiting Avenue (Water Street to Riverview Avenue)
 - The project is being scheduled for an April or possibly May award.
- **Additional Ongoing Director\City Engineer\City Surveyor Projects:**
 - The Engineering Department continues to work on improving the data management for public information as well as internally for decision making and planning for future capital projects.
 - The City Surveyor continues to work on several Certified Survey Maps for proposed and potential developments.
 - Engineering Department has also been working on other annual projects including:
 - Pavement Maintenance:
 - The bid opening has held on March 5th. As expected for this type of work, only one bidder, Fahrner Asphalt Sealers, submitted a bid. The total bid price was \$338,571.75
 - The retiming of approximately 15 signalized intersections, predominately located on the south and east side of the city are being completed this week.
 - Engineering Staff are looking into the possible replacement of existing 400 watt High Pressure Sodium street light luminaires along the Highway 10 corridor with more efficient LED luminaires. Currently staff are coordinating with WISDOT on permitting to ensure that photometric requirements are met.

2. Streets Division

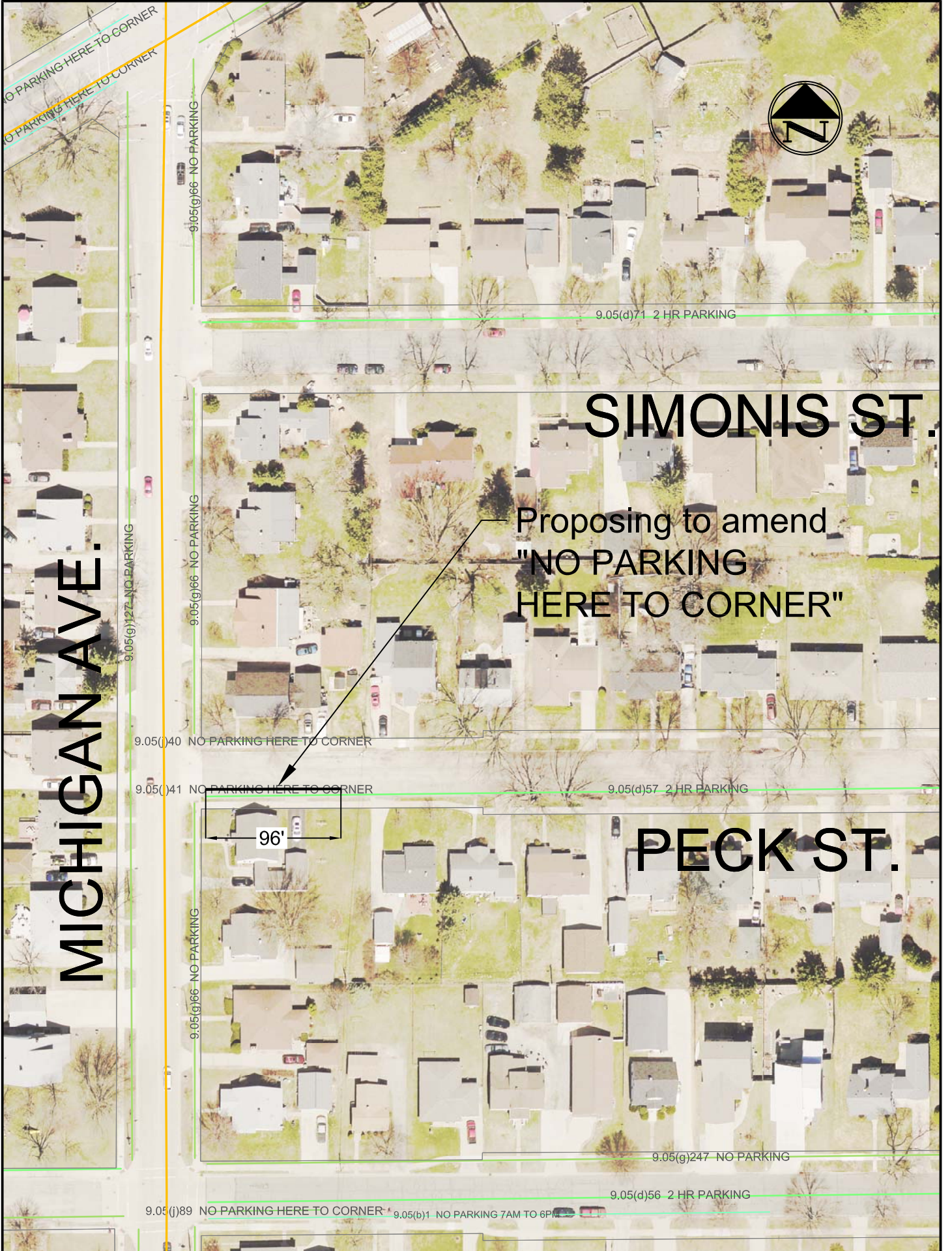
9.05(j) 41. On the south side of Peck Street from its intersection with Michigan Ave. to a point 96 east.
