Chief Barnes is requesting permission to promote a Deputy Chief at a salary equal to the two existing Deputy Chief's, \$54,394.88. Under the current pay plan, the minimum of this salary grade is \$49,605.03; the midpoint is \$57,071.73 and the maximum is \$63,412.37.

Alderman Hanson moved, Alderman Robinson seconded all ayes, to set the salary for the newly promoted Deputy Chief at \$54,394.88.
