Chair Rackow said a representative of the owner of the Best Western Royale has brought him a copy of the lease agreement which prohibits removal of the "Class B" Combination Beer and Liquor License from its premises. In response to a question, Attorney Molepske agreed that the agreement between the parties cannot bind the city. It will be up to attorneys for the parties to resolve the issue.

Ald. Wiza moved, Ald. Sowieja seconded, to approve the transfer of the license. Ayes, all; nays, none; motion carried.

2. Report on deer culling.

Ald. Rackow said the 65 deer contracted for have been removed. The recommendation to add 20 deer to the culling will be taken up by Finance Committee. No additional recipient names will be needed, as the list includes more than 20 names now.

In addition to the culling, 11 people removed five deer in the 10th District, and 26 people removed 8 deer in the airport area.
