2. Request from Michael C. Mitchell, Hilltop Pub & Grill, 4901 Main Street, Stevens Point, WI, to extend Class "B" licensed premise to Pfiffner Pioneer Park, for the 8th annual Stevens Point Spring Beer Festival, to be held on Saturday, May 3, 2003, from 1:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M.

Ald. Sevenich asked where the attendees will park and the location of the tents.

Clint Schultz, 110 West Willow Street, one of the event organizers, informed the Committee that parking will be on Crosby Avenue across from Pfiffner Pioneer Park. There will be two off-duty police officers present during the festival. Two large tents will be erected in the park. One tent is 60' x 120' which will be erected in front of the bandshell and the other tent will be 40' x 60' and will be erected east of the larger tent for food vendors. Mr. Schultz added that the entire festival grounds will be fenced off. There will be no vehicles in the park. Loading and unloading will be done off the street.

The festival will once again benefit the University of Wisconsin Stevens Point Athletic Development Fund, whose staff will assist the festival attendees.

Ald. Filipiak moved, Ald. Moore seconded, for approval of the request from Michael C. Mitchell of Hilltop Pub and Grill, 4901 Main Street, to extend his Class "B" licensed premise to Pfiffner Pioneer Park, for the 8th annual Stevens Point Spring Beer Festival, to be held on Saturday, May 3, 2003, from 1:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. The alternate location for the festival will be the K. B. Willett Arena in case of inclement weather.

3. Request to hold cruise - Truckin' Buddies Club - Saturday, August 9, 2003, starting at 6:30 P.M.

Police Captain Dowling stated the Police Department sees no problem with this request. The Captain is requesting that the event organizers seek volunteers to staff the intersections for this parade.

Ald. Moore moved, Ald. Filipiak seconded, to approve the request to hold a cruise for Truckin' Buddies Club on Saturday, August 9, 2003, starting

at 6:30 P.M., allowing the Police Department to chose the right route at a later date depending on road construction.

Police Captain Dowling reported there were no problems the previous years and is asking the event organizers to provide manpower at intersections of the parade route.
