BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS MEETING MINUTES

Thursday, March 21, 2002 4:25 p.m. Present: Mayor Wescott, C/T Schlice; Alderpersons Walther, Barr, Molski, Moore

1. Consideration of Bids: #1102 - Addition to Pfiffner Park Band Shell.

Parks and Recreation Director Schrader stated the Room Tax Committee approved \$85,000.00 in 2000 towards the addition to the Pfiffner Park Band Shell. The City's share of the \$85,000.00 is \$50,000 and \$35,000 is to come from private donations. So far only \$7,500.00 has been raised through the Community Foundation.

A cost of \$15,000.00 was added to the plan to cover the ramp at a cost of approximately \$5,000.00 to \$6,000.00 and a hand railing at a cost of approximately \$9,000.00. This addition will make it ADA accessible.

Director Schrader recommended holding off the project for sixty days and to direct it to the Board of Park Commissioners, Board of Public Works, and Finance Committee and ultimately to the Common Council for its action.

Since the Room Tax Committee is an advisory committee, Mayor Wescott said there is no need for the Committee to meet to review this project.

C/T Schlice moved, Ald. Barr seconded, to take no action on the bid for the addition to Pfiffner Park Band Shell and request the Board of Park Commissioners, Board of Public Works, and Finance Committee to review the matter again in their April meetings.

Ayes, all; nays, none. Motion carried.
