The request has been approved by Mayor Wescott.

Ald. Kedrowski moved, Ald. Sevenich seconded, for approval of the 1999-2000 Tentative Labor Agreement between the City of Stevens Point and Local 309 (Transit) AFSCME, AFL-CIO.
