1. License list.

Ald. Sevenich moved, Ald. Phillips seconded, to approve the new operator s (provisional) and renewal (2-year) operator licenses.

Recommended rejection of operator s (bartender s) license.

Ald. Walther moved, Ald. Phillips seconded, to deny the operator s (bartender s) license application for Matthew D. Eyles.

2. Garbage violation appeal - 1016 Franklin Street.

Ald. Nealis moved, Ald. Sevenich seconded, to deny the garbage violation appeal by the property owners of 1016 Franklin Street and that they bill the tenants the \$10.00 garbage violation charge.

3. Request to close portion of Reserve Street - Centertainment Productions - UWSP - May 5, 2000.

Police Captain Daubert stated the Police Department has no problem with this request but is concerned about the spillover into the neighborhood areas. **Since there was nobody from the Centertainment Productions in attendance at the meeting, the Police Department's concern was not addressed.**

Ald. Nealis moved, Ald. Sevenich seconded, for approval of the request to close a portion of Reserve Street on May 5, 2000, from 12:00 noon to 11:00 P.M. with the following contingencies: (a) the Fire Department is requesting that there be no non-removable structures placed on that portion of Reserve Street to be closed, in case of emergency, and (b) that there be no alcoholic beverages served in the area.

4. Trivia parade request - April 14, 2000.

Captain Daubert suggested the sponsors seek volunteers that could help with the traffic control situation for the parade which has been done in the past. Orange vests will be provided and orientation will be done by the Police Department.

Ald. Phillips moved, Ald. Walther seconded, to approve the parade request with an invitation to the sponsors to provide volunteers to help with traffic control with the help of the Police Department and advise the walkers in the parade to keep walking so it would not hold up the parade.
