1. License list.

Ald. Walther moved, Ald. Sevenich seconded, to approve the new operator s (provisional) license, renewal (2-year) operator license, renewal (year) manager s license, renewal (1 year) taxicab driver s license, Temporary Class "B" beer/ and "Class B" retailer s license and additional n operator s (provisional) and renewal (2-year) operator licenses.

Ayes, all; nays, none. Motion carried.

Recommended rejection of operator s (bartender s) license.

Kristian J. Prideaux was not present.

Police Captain Dowling stated that after further review of Mr. Prideaux police records, he found another OWI conviction in 1999, making a total of three OWI convictions in 1999, and one non-compliance with assessment interview.

Ald. Nealis moved, Ald. Phillips seconded, to deny the operator s (bartender s) license application for Kristian J. Prideaux.

2. Request to serve beer - Goerke Field - Spud Bowl - Saturday, September 9, 2000.

Police Captain Dowling stated this request has been done in the past several years and that there were no problems.

Ald. Phillips moved, Ald. Sevenich seconded, to approve the request to serve beer at Goerke Field for the Spud Bowl on Saturday, September 9, 2000.

Ayes, all; nays, none. Motion carried.

3. Truck cruise - Truckin Buddies Club - Saturday, August 12, 2000.

The Truckin Buddies Club s request for a truck cruise was approved by the Public Protection Committee and the Common Council at their September 1999 meetings. The request at this time is for the Committee to review the cruise route, as shown on the attached map.

The cruise organizers discussed the cruise route with Police Sergeant Carlson and came up with a route that would work for everybody.

Captain Dowling said, as has been done in the past, the Police Department is asking the club members to provide the necessary volunteers to staff the intersections.

Ald. Sevenich moved, Ald. Phillips seconded, for approval of the truck cruise route for Truckin Buddies Club on Saturday, August 12, 2000.

4. Inspection Report.

Director Gardner said the current building of houses in the City is at a faster rate than that of last year.

The total valuation is less than last year but with the expected ground breaking on Wednesday, July 12, 2000, the valuation can change.

Ald. Phillips moved, Ald. Sevenich seconded, to accept the Inspection Report and place it on file.
