The Smongeski Health Fund has been operated through the City Clerk's office for the past 38 years. With the closure of SHOPKO, Trig's became the vendor for Vitamins and toothbrushes in February 2019. The following statistics cover the period from August 1, 2018 through July 31, 2019.

The Fund currently has 58 families signed up for assistance in addition to providing financial support to other programs such as Healthy Smiles, Maternal and Child Health, and Project Fresh Start programs.

There was another increase from last year with the distribution of vitamins and toothbrushes. When we switched providers we mailed participants a notice reminding them of the Fund and the services we provide. We will also work with the schools again to send information out to families with children on free or reduced lunch. Currently, we provide Prevention Magazine to Ben Franklin Jr High, PJ Jacobs Jr High and Pacelli High School. The subscription cost for this fiscal year to \$108.00.

We increased the funding to Healthy Smiles this last year to the \$6,000.00 level. We did not have any costs for sealants payable directly to a dentist this year.

There was one purchase of eye glasses this year through WalMart.
