1. Canvass the municipal results of the February 15, 2011, Spring Primary Election and correct any errors or irregularities as a result of such canvass.

The Canvass Committee was presented the Clerk's absentee ballot log, Certificate of Ballots, the poll books, the voting machines printouts (opening reports and closing reports) and Inspectors Statements for review. Clerk Moe noted that they would not be reviewing tally sheets because the only municipal question on the ballot is the referendum question which is a yes or no response. Tally sheets list write-in candidates.

The Canvass Committee reviewed the material by Aldermanic district.

In District 2, Clerk Moe noted that his office received an opened absentee ballot so they sent out and received back a second absentee ballot from this person. His staff informed him that SVRS does not allow them to issue two ballots so the first was deleted from the system. So the number for ballots was not changed but the first ballot, which was received open, was rejected by the poll workers and the second ballot was counted.

In District 4, Clerk Moe noted that two additional absentee ballots came in after the Absentee ballot log was run.

In District 11, Clerk Moe noted that one additional absentee ballot came in after the Absentee ballot log was run.

After reviewing all the districts the committee filled out the Summary of the Canvass and the Tabular Statement of Votes and signed the Certificate of the Canvass.
