

## **STEVENS POINT CANVASSING COMMITTEE**

Wednesday, April 6, 2011 – 3:15 P.M.

### **1. Canvass the municipal results of the April 5, 2011, Spring Election and correct any errors or irregularities as a result of such canvass.**

The Canvassing Committee convened at 3:15 p.m. and then went into recess until 6:30 p.m.

The Canvass Committee was presented the Clerk's absentee log, Certificate of Ballots, the poll books, the Central Count printouts, the tally sheets, and Inspector Statements for review.

The Canvass Committee reviewed the material by district.

District #1, after reviewing the write-in tally sheet the Committee rejected two of the three write-ins for Mayor and struck one of the five write-ins for alderpersons. After reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows: Mayor: Wiza received 265, Halverson received 256, Yudchitz received 14, Write-ins 1. Alderperson: Myers Sr. 154, Fritch 102, Beveridge 228, Write-ins 4.

District #2, after reviewing the write-in tally sheet the Committee rejected one of the three write-ins for Mayor. After reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows: Mayor: Wiza received 137, Halverson received 214, Yudchitz received 9, Write-ins 2.

District #3, after reviewing the write-in tally sheet the Committee rejected one write-in. After reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows: Mayor: Wiza received 179, Halverson received 249, Yudchitz received 14, Write-ins 9. Alderperson: Michael O'Meara received 108, Write-ins 14.

District #4, after reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows: Mayor: Wiza received 403, Halverson received 229, Yudchitz received 10, Write-ins 4.

District #5, after reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows: Mayor: Wiza received 268, Halverson received 329, Yudchitz received 13, Write-ins 5. Alderperson: M. Stroik received 303, Brown received 243, Write-ins 2.

District #6, the machine noted three write-ins but the poll workers could only find 2 write-ins.

After reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows: Mayor: Wiza received 410, Halverson received 744, Yudchitz received 14, Write-ins 2.

District #7, after reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows:

Mayor: Wiza received 392, Halverson received 513, Yudchitz received 21, Write-ins 4.  
Aldersperson: Trzebiatowski received 450, Ananiadis received 377, Write-ins 2. After reviewing the write-in tally sheet the Committee rejected one write-in for Aldersperson.

District #8, after reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows:

Mayor: Wiza received 311, Halverson received 594, Yudchitz received 21, Write-ins 2.

District #9, after reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows:

Mayor: Wiza received 296, Halverson received 351, Yudchitz received 16, Write-ins 2.  
Aldersperson: R. Stroik received 454, Write-ins 12. After reviewing the write-in tally sheet the Committee rejected four write-ins for Aldersperson as they were not real people.

District #10, after reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows:

Mayor: Wiza received 345, Halverson received 318, Yudchitz received 12, Write-ins 2.

District #11, after reviewing all the documents the Committee determined the results as follows:

Mayor: Wiza received 174, Halverson received 216, Yudchitz received 16, Write-ins 3.  
Aldersperson: Moore received 166, Presley received 148, Write-ins 7. The Committee struck one write-in from the Mayor's race and one from the Aldermanic race as both were not real people.
