**CANVASSING COMMITTEE MINUTES**

There were a total of 16 late arriving ballots. District 1 – 1 ballot; District 2 – 1 ballot; District 4 – 1 ballot; District 6 – 2 ballots; District 7 – 9 ballots; District 8 – 1 ballot; District 11 – 1 ballot.

District 1: 2 signatures were noted on the ballot envelope, it was postmarked 2/19/2013, it was not tampered with and the Committee recommended to count it.

District 2: The ballot envelope was reviewed and it was noted that no signatures were on the envelope. The Committee recommended to reject the ballot.

District 4: One ballot for this District, Committee found it to be sufficient. Molski pulled the ballot from the privacy container and noted there was no vote on the ballot. Therefore, the results did not change in this District.

District 6: The Committee noted 2 acceptable ballots both having signatures and postmarked accordingly. The Committee recommended to count the ballots.

District 7: There were 9 late arriving ballots in this District. The Committee noted there were a total of 3 rejected ballots due to late postmarks and 6 good ballots that were counted by the Committee.

District 8: One late ballot and there appeared to be a slight tear at the top of the envelope. The Committee determined it was not tampered and it was deemed sufficient. The ballot was opened and put in the privacy container. Molski noted no vote on the ballot therefore no change in this District results.

District 11: There was one late ballot found sufficient and the Committee recommended to count it.

There were 10 ballots tallied, 2 blank ballots and 4 rejected ballots for a total of 16 ballots.
