District 1: There were 7 write-ins for Alderperson of which the Board of Canvassers struck 1 vote. Total count changed to 6 write-ins and 363 total voters.

District 2: No changes were noted by the Board of Canvassers.

District 3: There were a total of 8 write-in votes for Alderperson of which the Board of Canvassers struck 1 vote.

District 4: No changes were noted by the Board of Canvassers.

District 5: There were a total of 7 write-in votes for Alderperson of which the Board of Canvassers struck 1 vote.

District 6: No changes were noted by the Board of Canvassers.

District 7: There were a total of 3 write-in votes for Alderperson of which the Board of Canvassers struck 1 vote.

District 8: A total of 46 absentee votes were delivered to the polling place; however, 1 of those envelopes was empty. Per the Government Accountability Board, it is a no vote.

District 9: There were a total of 2 write-in votes for City Clerk of which the Board of Canvassers struck 1 vote; there were a total of 3 write-in votes for Comptroller/Treasurer of which the Board of Canvassers struck 1 vote; there were a total of 4 write-in votes for City Attorney of which the Board of Canvassers struck 2 votes.

District 10: No changes were noted by the Board of Canvassers.

District 11: There were a total of 2 write-in votes for Alderperson of which the Board of Canvassers struck 1 vote.

LATE ARRIVING BALLOTS

There were a total of 4 late arriving ballots all in District 6.

The Committee noted 4 acceptable ballots both having signatures and postmarked accordingly. The Committee recommended to count the ballots.

There were 4 ballots tallied.
