CANVASSING COMMITTEE MINUTES
Monday, April 13, 2015 9:00 a.m.
Conference Room D – 1516 Church Street

The Committee is to certify the election results as well as process any late-arriving absentee ballots or provisional ballots. The Canvass Committee was presented with the Clerk's absentee log, Certificate of Ballots, the poll books and each District's DS200 printouts, the tally sheets and Inspector Statements for review along with any late-arriving absentee ballots or provisional ballots.

Clerk Moe stated there were no provisional ballots but there were 5 late-arriving absentee ballots from Districts 2,4,7,9,11.

District 1: Total voter count was 353 with no changes. DS200 machine registered 353 ballots recorded. Total absentee ballots were 17. There were no registered write-in candidates. Unregistered write-ins are referred to as scattering.

District 2: Total voter count was 276 with no changes. DS200 machine registered 276 ballots recorded. Total absentee ballots were 23. There were no registered write-in candidates.

District 3: Total voter count was 203 with no changes. DS200 registered 203 ballots recorded. Total absentee ballots were 19. There were no registered write-in candidates.

District 4: Total voter count was 398 with no changes. DS200 registered 398 ballots recorded. Total absentee ballots were 30. There were no registered write-in candidates.

District 5: Total voter count was 459 with no changes. DS200 registered 459 ballots recorded. Total absentee ballots were 37. There were no registered write-in candidates.

District 6: Total voter count was 489 with no changes. DS200 registered 489 ballots recorded. Total absentee ballots were 34. There were no registered write-in candidates.

District 7: Total voter count was 401 with no changes. DS200 registered 401 ballots recorded. Total absentee ballots were 56. There were no registered write-in candidates.

District 8: Total voter count was 574 with no changes. DS200 registered 574 ballots recorded. Total absentee ballots were 35. There were no registered write-in candidates.

District 9: Total voter count was 450 with no changes. DS200 registered 450 ballots registered. Total absentee ballots were 38. There were no registered write-

in candidates.

District 10: Total voter count was 469 with no changes. DS200 registered 469 ballots recorded. Total absentee ballots were 47. There were no registered write-in candidates.

District 11: Total voter count was 199 with no changes. DS200 registered 199 ballots recorded. Total absentee ballots were 51. There were no registered write-in candidates.

There were no discrepancies with the poll books, Chief Inspector's Statements and DS200 machine tape in all 11 districts.

LATE ARRIVING BALLOTS

Total late arriving absentee ballots were 5 for districts 2,4,7,9,11.

District 11: There was 1 late arriving absentee ballots acceptable with having 2 signatures and postmarked accordingly. The vote count was: Mike Wiza 1, Shaun Morrow 1.

District 9: There was 1 late arriving absentee ballot with acceptable signatures and postmarked accordingly. The vote count was: Jerry Moore 1, Ald. R. Stroik 1.

District 7: There was 1 late arriving ballot. It was the recommendation of the Committee to reject this ballot due to the postmark dated April 8, 2015, which was after the election.

District 4: There was 1 late arriving ballot with acceptable signatures and postmarked accordingly. There was 1 vote Daly for Chief Justice. No other votes for Mayor, alderperson or school board were noted.

District 2: There was 1 late arriving ballot. It was the recommendation of the Committee to reject this ballot due to the postmark of April 8, 2015, after the election.

The final result was:

District 2 with no changes.

District 4 with no municipal changes only a judicial change.

District 11 with Mike Wiza +1 bringing his total to 140, Shaun Morrow +1 bringing his total to 98.

District 9 with Jerry Moore +1 bringing his total to 140 and R. Stroik +1 bringing his total to 188.

District 7 with no changes.
