CANVASSING COMMITTEE MINUTES FEBRUARY 22, 2016 9 a.m.
City Conference Room

PRESENT: City Clerk John Moe. Marge Molski; Mike Phillips.

Clerk Moe called the Board of Canvass to order at 9:00 a.m.

The Committee is to certify the election results as well as process any late-arriving absentee ballots or provisional ballots. The Canvass Committee was presented with the City Clerk's absentee log, Certificate of ballots, the poll books, the tally sheets and Inspector Statements for review along with any late-arriving absentee ballots or provisional ballots.

Clerk Moe stated there were no provisional ballots but there were 9 absentee ballots from Districts 4, 7, 8 and 9.

District 1: There were no absentee or provisional ballots.

District 2: There were no absentee or provisional ballots.

District 3: There were no absentee or provisional ballots.

District 4: There were 2 absentee envelopes which were accepted. Voter numbers 246 and 247 were assigned. The results of absentee voting were: one (1) vote for Bradley; one (1) vote for Shannon; one (1) vote Kloppenberg; one (1) Redfield.

District 5: There were no absentee or provisional ballots.

District 6: There were no absentee or provisional ballots.

District 7: There was one absentee envelope which was accepted. Voter number 291 was assigned. The results of absentee voting were: one (1) vote Kloppenberg; one (1) vote Baker.

District 8: There was 1 absentee envelope which was accepted. Voter number 459 was assigned. The results of absentee voting was one (1) vote for Kloppenberg. No vote was cast for the Portage County Judicial Branch 2 candidates.

District 9: There were five (5) absentee envelopes which all were accepted. Voter numbers 253, 254, 255, 256 and 257 were assigned. The results of absentee voting were: two (2) votes Kloppenberg; three (3) votes Bradley; one (1) vote Baker; one (1) vote Knaapen; three (3) votes Shannon.

The final result was nine (9) absentee ballots and all were postmarked, signed, dated and witnessed correctly. After review of all the districts, the Committee completed the Summary of the Canvass and the Tabular Statement of votes and signed the Certificate of Canvass.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:00 a.m.
