

**BOARD OF CANVASS
NOVEMBER 14, 2016
CONFERENCE ROOM D**

PRESENT: City Clerk John Moe, Marge Molski, John Pearson, John Kraft, Carol Ligman.

The Board of Canvass was called to order by Clerk John Moe at 9:00 a.m. November 14, 2016.

Clerk Moe stated he would recuse himself from the proceedings.

Marge Molski was directed to record the actions of the Board on the appropriate Canvass documents.

DISTRICT #1: Wards 1, 2, 3

One provisional ballot was cast due to the voter unable to provide photo ID and his driver's license number. The voter returned and photo ID as well as license number was provided and documented.

The seal on the ballot bag was verified. The voter number was 1268 with 1 provisional voter bringing the total to 1269. One vote was cast for each of the following: President/Vice-President: Clinton/Kane; U.S. Senator: Feingold; Representative in Congress: Kind; State Senator: Lassa; Representative to State Assembly: Shankland; D.A.: Molepski; County Clerk: Simonis; County Treasurer Mallison; Register of Deeds: Wisinski; Surveyor: Trzinski; Referendum: No.

DISTRICT #7: Wards 19, 20, 21

One provisional ballot was cast due to the voter unable to provide photo I.D. The voter returned to provide the required photo I.D.

The seal and ballot bag number were verified. The last voter number in the pollbook was 1,158 with 1 provisional ballot cast bringing the new voter number to 1,159. One vote was cast for each of the following offices: President/Vice-President: Clinton/Kane; U.S. Senator: Feingold; Representative in Congress: No vote cast; State Senator: Lassa; Representative to State Assembly: No vote cast; Portage County D.A.: No vote cast; County Clerk: No vote cast; County Treasurer: No vote cast; Register of Deeds: No vote cast; Surveyor: No vote cast; Referendum: No vote cast.

DISTRICT #8: Wards 22, 23, 24

Two voters were issued provisional ballots which should not have been. These ballots were ineligible to count because proof of residency at the time of registration was not provided. These voters were called and the circumstances were explained to each of them.

DISTRICT #2: Wards 4, 5, 6

In this district, there were four more voters than ballots. Two absentee ballots were not counted and need to be added to the final tape results. Two additional ballots were found in the voting equipment marked in blue ink and should be subtracted from the final count.

The two ballots marked in blue ink were located in ballot bag #75897. The votes for ballot #1 was as follows: President/Vice-President: Trump/Kane; U.S. Senator: Johnson; Representative in Congress: Kind; State Senator: Testin; Representative to State Assembly: Shankland; County District Attorney: Molepski; County Clerk: Simonis; County Treasurer: Mallison; Register of Deeds: Wisinski; Surveyor: Trzinski; Referendum: No.

Ballot #2 was as follows: President/Vice-President: Clinton/Kane; U.S. Senator: Feingold; Representative in Congress: Kind; State Senator: Lassa; State Representative: Shankland; County D.A. Molepski; County Clerk: Simonis; County Treasurer: Mallison; Register of Deeds: Wisinski; Surveyor: Trzinski; Referendum: No.

The two ballots were then resealed b in a new ballot bag #75896.

Additionally, there were 2 absentee ballots that had been found on 11-9-16 among the opened absentee envelopes. Carol Ligman believes these two ballots had not been counted. The Board agrees that these two ballots should be counted, so the number of ballots will equal the number of voters.

Ballot #2: President/Vice-President: Clinton/Kane; U.S. Senator: Feingold; Representative in Congress: Kind; State Senator: Lassa; Representative in State Assembly: No vote; Portage County D.A.: Molepski; County Clerk: Simonis; Treasurer: Mallison; Register of Deeds; Wisinski; Surveyor: Trzinski; Referendum: Yes.

The above ballots were then secured in a new ballot bag, #75935.
