CANVASSING BOARD**

Monday, April 10, 2017 – 9:00 A.M.

Portage County Courthouse, 1516 Church St. – Conference Room D

Present: Clerk Moe, Mary Ann Bieno, John Pearson.

1. Canvass the municipal results and any provisional ballots for the April 4, 2017 Spring Election and correct any errors or irregularities as a result of such canvass.

The Canvass Committee was presented the Inspector's Statements, the poll books, the DS900 printouts, absentee ballot log and the write-in tally sheets for each reporting unit.

The Canvass Committee reviewed the material for Aldermanic and City-wide Office races.

In District #1, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 221 votes and a scattering received 3 votes, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 224 votes and a scattering received 1 vote, for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 229 votes and a scattering received 4 votes, and for District #1 Alderperson Tori Jennings received 226 votes, George Doxtator received 86 votes and scattering received zero votes.

In District #2, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 129 votes and a scattering received 1 vote, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 124 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, and for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 127 votes and a scattering received 1 vote.

In District #3, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 136 votes and a scattering received 3 votes, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 134 votes and a scattering received 1 vote, for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 127 votes and a scattering received 2 votes, and for District #3 Alderperson Cindy Nebel received 124 votes, Chris Villarreal received 42 votes and a scattering received 1 vote.

In District #4, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 160 votes and a scattering received 1 vote, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 152 votes and a scattering received 1 vote, and for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 146 votes and a scattering received 2 votes.

In District #5, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 176 votes and a scattering received 1 vote, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 179 votes and a scattering received 1 vote, for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 177 votes and a scattering received 1 vote, and for District #5 Alderperson Meleesa Johnson received 178 votes and a scattering received 3 votes.

In District #6, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 210 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 216 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, and for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 200 votes and a scattering received 0 votes.

In District #7, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 163 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 166 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 157 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, and for District #7 Alderperson Mary Kneebone received 162 votes and a scattering received 2 votes.

In District #8, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 258 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 253 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, and for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 242 votes and a scattering received 0 votes.

In District #9, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 210 votes and a scattering received 6 votes, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 211 votes and a scattering received 3 votes, for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 209 votes and a scattering received 4 votes, and for District #9 Alderperson Mary McComb received 194 votes, Polly Dalton received 118 votes and a scattering received 4 votes. District #9 had one provisional ballot that remained sealed and uncounted because the elector did not bring in the proper documentation by the statutory deadline.

In District #10, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 168 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 172 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, and for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 164 votes and a scattering received 0 votes.

At 9:48 a.m. Clerk Moe called for a recess in order to retrieve the Ballot bags.

At 9:53 a.m. the meeting was reconvened.

In District #11, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for City Clerk John Moe received 110 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 106 votes and a scattering received 0 votes, for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 102 votes and a scattering received 1 vote, and for District #11 Alderperson Shaun Morrow received 111 votes and a scattering received 1 vote.

In summary for the City Offices: for City Clerk John Moe received 1941 votes with 15 scattering votes, for Comptroller-Treasurer Corey Ladick received 1937 votes with 7 scattering votes, and for City Attorney Andrew L. Beveridge received 1880 votes with 15 scattering votes.
