1. Canvass the municipal results and any provisional ballots for the February 20, 2018 Spring Primary and correct any errors or irregularities as a result of such canvass.

At 9:01 a.m. Clerk Moe called for a recess in order to retrieve the forgotten poll book for District 8.

At 9:04 a.m. the meeting was reconvened.

The Canvass Committee was presented the Inspector's Statements, the poll book, the DS900 printout, absentee ballot log, provisional ballot log EL-123r, and the write-in tally sheet for each reporting unit.

The Canvass Committee reviewed the material for Aldermanic District 8 race.

In District #8, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for District # 8 Alderperson Cathy Dugan received 201 votes, Al Prosser received 37 votes, Lynn M. Schulist received 173 votes and scattering received 1 vote. The two candidates moving on to the April election are: Cathy Dugan and Lynn M. Schulist.

In District #6, a mother of an absentee voter brought in sealed incomplete ballot envelope with a completed ballot inside. After talking with City Clerk's staff the mother gave the ballot to the Chief Inspector and told her to throw it away. Once a ballot has been delivered it cannot be thrown away and the ballot was placed in the tote and was forgotten about. The ballot was found the morning after the election in the tote by a City Clerk's staff member and was secured until the meeting. A copy of the absentee ballot log was presented along with the absentee ballot. Due to the voter and the witness failing to sign the envelope, the ballot was rejected.
