1. Canvass provisional ballots for the April 2, 2019 Spring Election.

Clerk Piotrowski said there were two provisional ballots that were cast. He said one person came back and showed proper proof of id.

The committee reviewed the documents for the provisional voter.

Clerk Piotrowski opened the ballot bag and the provisional ballot envelope.

The committee assigned voter number 476 to the provisional voter in both poll books. The committee fixed the tallies on the tape to reflect the votes cast on the ballot.

Clerk Piotrowski sealed the ballot in a secured envelope. Clerk Piotrowski updated the Inspector Statement. The Board of Canvass members signed the ballot bag.

2. Canvass City Races: Mayor, City Clerk, Odd Numbered Aldermanic Districts.

In District #1, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 340 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 311 votes, District #1 Alderperson Shannon Semmerling received 162 votes, Tori Jennings received 230 votes.

In District #2, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 225 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 203 votes.

In District #3, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 221 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 201 votes, District #3 Alderperson Cindy Nebel received 157 votes, Amelia DelGreco received 62 votes.

In District #4, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 268 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 254.

In District #5, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 368 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 336 votes, District #5 Alderperson Meleesa Johnson received 248 votes, Brian Jurgella received 160 votes.

In District #6, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 463 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 433 votes.

In District #7, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 307 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 299 votes, District #7 Alderperson Mary Kneebone received 289 votes.

In District #8, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 469 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 432 votes.

In District #9, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 388 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 356 votes, District #9 Alderperson Mary McComb received 170 votes, Polly Dalton received 271 votes, Write-Ins received 64 votes.

In District #10, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 359 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 351 votes.

In District #11, after review of the materials, the Committee determined the results to be as follows: for Mayor Mike Wiza received 175 votes, City Clerk Paul Piotrowski received 159 votes, District #11 Alderperson Shaun Morrow received 152 votes.

In summary for the City Offices: for Mayor Mike Wiza 3,573 votes, for City Clerk Paul Piotrowski 3,335 votes, for District #1 Alderperson Tori Jennings 230 votes, for District #3 Alderperson Cindy Nebel 157 votes, for District #5 Alderperson Meleesa Johnson 248 votes, for District #7 Alderperson Mary Kneebone 289 votes, for District #9 Alderperson Polly Dalton 271 votes, for District #11 Alderperson Shaun Morrow 152 votes.
