



Health and Safety Guidelines for Stevens Point Parks, Recreation & Forestry Facility Rentals

Facilities are open as long as the following rules are adhered to.

- Observe the recommendation on mass gatherings per the PORTAGE COUNTY COVID-19 ORDER #1 by Portage County Health & Human Services.

Mass Gatherings: Individuals should avoid situations where you are unable to exercise appropriate physical distancing with non-household members. Social settings of more than 50 people, where appropriate distancing may not be practical or possible, should be avoided unless precautionary measures are observed.

- **Permits shall only be valid if attendance is less than or equal to 50 people per Stevens Point Board of Park Commissioners.**
- EMERGENCY ORDER #3 LIMITING PUBLIC GATHERINGS (25% of capacity) by the Office of the Governor.
 1. Definitions.
 - ii. Places that are not open to the public, and therefore are not part of the definition of a public gathering and are not limited by this order, include, but are not limited to:
 1. Office spaces, manufacturing plant, and other facilities that are accessible only by employees or other authorized personnel.
 2. Invitation-only events that exclude uninvited guests.
 3. Private residences. Except, a residence is considered open to the public during an event that allows entrance to any individual; such public gatherings are limited to 10 people.
- Observe required face coverings per the STATE OF WISCONSIN EMERGENCY ORDER #1 by the Office of the Governor.

FACE COVERING REQUIRED. Every individual, age five and older, in Wisconsin shall wear a face covering if both of the following apply:

- a. The individual is indoors or in an enclosed space, other than at a private residence; and;
- b. Another person or persons who are not members of individual's household or living unit are present in the same room or enclosed space.

Failure to abide by the requirements listed above may result in a forfeiture issued in the form of a local ordinance citation and/or state civil forfeiture.

- Maintain and observe a minimum of 6' of physical distancing at all times while using City facilities and properties including outdoor spaces.
