



The Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC) document will help you choose a health **plan**. The SBC shows you how you and the **plan** would share the cost for covered health care services. NOTE: Information about the cost of this **plan** (called the **premium**) will be provided separately. This is only a summary. What is the overall deductible ?	\$1,500 person / \$3,000 family In-network \$2,500 person / \$5,000 family Out-of-network	Generally, you must pay all the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan , the overall family deductible must be met before the plan begins to pay.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible ?	Yes. Preventive care services are covered before you meet your deductible .	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible . Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services.
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan ?	\$6,400 person / \$12,900 family In-network \$8,900 person / \$17,900 family Out-of-network \$6,400 In-network / \$8,900 Out-of-network Maximum amount that any one person will satisfy towards the annual family out-of-pocket	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan , they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit ?	Penalties, premiums , balance billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit .

Will you pay less if you use a [network provider](#)?

This [plan](#) uses a [provider network](#). You will pay less if you use a [provider](#) in the [plan's network](#). You will pay the most if you use an [out-of-network provider](#), and you might receive a bill from a [provider](#) for the difference between the [provider's](#) charge and what your [plan](#) pays ([balance billing](#)). Be aware, your [network provider](#) might use an [out-of-network provider](#) for some services (such as lab work). Check with your [provider](#) before you get services.

Do you need a [referral](#) to see a [specialist](#)?

Does this [plan](#) Provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes

[Minimum Essential Coverage](#) generally includes [plans](#), [health insurance](#) available through the [Marketplace](#) or other individual market policies, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, TRICARE, and certain other coverage. If you are eligible for certain types of [Minimum Essential Coverage](#), you may not be eligible for the [premium tax credit](#).

Does this [plan](#) Meet the Minimum Value Standard? Yes

Peg is Having a Baby
